Indian Americans Break With India

WASHINGTON, DC - Indian Americans plan to issue a forceful denouncement of Russia's invasion of Ukraine to shield themselves from the fallout of the Indian government's continued refusal to condemn the war, which has drawn widespread scrutiny and criticism from within and out of US policy circles.

A bipartisan group of well-connected Indian American political operatives are expecting to hold a seminar on Capitol Hill on theme of "Indian Americans Against Genocide in Ukraine", one of the organizers said. June 22 is the tentative date being considered and the event is likely to be headlined by a leading yoga guru and attended by many US lawmakers.

Stolen in 1967, Exhibited in LACMA, 10th Century Statue Finally Returns to India

SAN FRANCISCO, CA - A stolen ancient Indian artefact of a 'Buddha in Dharma Chakra Mudra' was handed over to India's Consul General here, Dr. T.V. Nagendra Prasad by the U.S. Department of Justice and Department of Homeland Security representatives. At a solemn ceremony held at the historic Gadar Memorial, on April 21, the U.S. team, led by Supervisory Special Agent Chad Fredrickson, handed over the 10th-century bronze statue back to India. The statue was believed to have been stolen in February 1967 from India's Archeological

Survey of India Museum in Nalanda. The statue was acquired by intermediaries and donated to the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) where it was exhibited.

Majumdar is the Jay Precourt Professor, professor of mechanical engineering, senior fellow and former co-director of the Precourt Institute for Energy, and a senior fellow at the Hoover Institution, where he co-chairs the George Shultz Energy and Climate Task Force. He joined Stanford in 2014 after a career that spanned academic research and experience in industry, national laboratories, and government, where he led efforts implementing energy technology initiatives, the university said. Majumdar currently serves as the chair of the advisory board to the U.S. Secretary of Energy. After leaving Washington and before joining Stanford, Majumdar was the Vice President for Energy at Google, where he assembled a team to create technologies and businesses at the intersection of data, computing, and electricity grid. Majumdar attended Mayo College in India, has a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering from IIT, Bombay and got his Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley in 1989.

"I am deeply honored and humbled by the opportunity to serve as the inaugural dean," Majumdar said. "Building on the extraordinary leadership of Kam Moler and Steve Graham, we will not only harness the intellectual horsepower of our students, faculty, and staff across our campus, but we will also partner with external organizations around the world to co-develop innovative solutions and identify new insights through research and education. As is often said, we do not inherit the Earth from our ancestors; we borrow it from our children. We must collectively figure out how to create a future where humans and nature thrive together."

Majumdar will assume his new position June 15, Stanford News reported. At that time Kathryn "Kam" Moler, who has been transition dean of the school since December 2021 and has co-led the transition since May 2020, will resume her role as vice provost and dean of research, a role she has held since 2018. Stephan Graham, who has been serving as transition vice dean, will continue his role as the dean of the School of Earth, Energy, and Environmental Sciences (Stanford Earth) until the school stops operating September 1. The people, research, and academic programs of Stanford Earth will become part of the Stanford Doer School of Sustainability.

"I'm thrilled that Arun Majumdar has agreed to take on this critical role," said Stanford Provost Persis Drill, who led an international search to identify an inaugural dean who is an eminent scholar and can advance the school's focus on impact.

"I am delighted that Arun is willing to serve as inaugural dean of the Doer School of Sustainability," said Stanford President Marc Tessier-Lavigne.

'India's Padwoman' Making A Difference

Like many aspiring Indian students, I came to America in 1994 to pursue higher studies and find a dream job. I remember always paying auto drivers back in India extra money, thinking they needed it much more than I did. The desire to serve was there, yet as a student in a middle-class family, the need to secure a good career was paramount. After graduating from the University of Maryland at College Park with an MBA, I started work as a management consultant with PricewaterhouseCoopers.

Back then, online shopping was not as ubiquitous as it is today. One of our projects with

a major retail outlet entailed putting internet kiosks in stores so that if a customer couldn't find a T-shirt in the size or color they wanted, they could still order it, and the store would not lose that customer. I would sit in meetings and wonder if this was how I would spend the


rest of my life. Helping people who already made lots of money make even more money?

Feeling disillusioned, I decided to quit this job. Fortunately for me, my husband supported me. We learned about the wonderful humanitarian projects inspired by Sri Mata Amritanandamavi Devi (Amma) that served those in need. We relocated to India in 2003 and started volunteering with the NGO Amma had founded. In 2013, when the NGO adopted underdeveloped villages nationwide, I saw first-hand the problems faced by rural women and girls and under-

stood the urgent need to provide high-quality and low-cost products for menstrual hygiene.

Most sanitary napkins sold globally are made with cellulose fiber obtained by cutting trees. The amount of waste generated by mainstream sanitary products is astronomical. According to the Menstrual Health Alliance India, one sanitary pad takes 500 to 800 years to decompose. As we sought the ideal solution, we understood that it would be foolish to promote a single-use model in rural India.

I had used cloth pads for nearly a decade, starting while still living in the US. I knew how reusable pads made for a much more wholesome period experience. We set about making the world's



Reusable menstrual pads are better for our seas, trees, bodies, and wallets. They cost, on average, onetenth the amount one must otherwise spend on disposable sanitary napkins month after month.

This year, on International Women's Day, Niti Aayog, the premier policy think tank of the Government of India, recognized Saukhyam as one of the strong roots for tomorrow's India. I received the prestigious Women Transforming India Award. I am often referred to as "Padwoman of India." Turns out, helping sell reusable menstrual pads made by

> It's been quite a journey from corporate America to rural India, where my team and I primarily work. International Menstrual Hygiene Day (May 28th) is around the corner and it's our vision that reusable prod-

ucts become mainstream. Disposable can never be sustainable and our planet does not have enough resources for us to endlessly take, make, use and discard. Change is imminent, and we are grateful to be playing a small part in making that happen. We have so much more to do. To learn more and support the cause:

Regardless of the universal values that Mohiniyattam has to offer, I often like to pose questions like - "Why do you dance?" and "What does Indian classical dance mean to you?" to the Indian audience and Indian American youth here. To be prodded to think about "why" we do what we do, is disconcerting to most and perhaps largely stems from the mechanistic approach of the West that many have been inevitably influenced by. In fact, it is a fundamental question anyone who dances, ought to ask of themselves, and not just from the diaspora.

The "why" actually applies to every aspect of our lives, so it is critical and invaluable to investigate and seek answers. Especially, given that our Indian dance traditions are not just limited to physical movement, but reflect a deep mind-body experience, rooted in the spiritual. Apart from the obvious reason of connecting with our culture, is it the ultimate objective to secure an Arangetram under one's belt, or get extra credits for college admissions, only to relinquish it sooner than later? The Arangetram, has come to become more of a social gathering and is a contrast to its original, modest intentions - that of the young student presenting her/his debut. Isn't the process and experience of learning & imbibing the values that Indian dance epitomizes the most important aspect?

I also urge the community to be open to all forms of dance, so that their child has adequate exposure to the various Indian forms and is then able to focus on the one that he or she truly enjoys and feels most natural with. Parents, who have grown up in India, lament the fact that their children are part of a society that believes that Indian culture is defined by Pop culture. These are parents who feel grateful and privileged to have experienced the classical and folk arts back home, during their formative years, while their children have little access to that, besides misleading notions of our culture and values. Though one has to concede, that there is a much more concerted effort on the part of the parents outside the country to remain tenaciously connected to their traditions than in India, where society is blindly emulating the west and even embarrassed to own the Indian ethos.

It is imperative, that the Indian American youth understand, that Indian classical dance is a very therapeutic, empowering and spiritual experience, that can impact our lives forever if we so choose. That most of all, Indian dance is about the experience and is not limited to being an event.

Vijayalakshmi is a world-renowned exponent of Mohiniyattam, the classical dance form from South India. She has performed at some of the most prestigious venues in India and around the globe, including the Bolshoi Theatre, the Edinburgh International Festival, and the Lincoln Centre. She was awarded the distinguished Regents Lectureship program at UCLA in 2020. She is the Founder-Director of The Mohiniyattam Institute, Los Angeles and the Artistic-Director of the Centre for Mohiniyattam, New Delhi.

In 2017, we launched Saukhyam Reusable Pads. To date, we have sold and distributed over 500,000 pads, helping prevent the emission of 2000 tons of carbon dioxide equivalent annually. Our work has also helped eliminate 43,750 tons of non-biodegradable waste. The pads are made in rural India and are now also exported to the US, UK, Germany, Spain, Netherlands, Kuwait, and Nepal.

Vinod Bhindi Recognized for Outstanding Industry Contributions, Receives Award From President of Fiji



May the Almighty continue to bless Fiji and each of us. Vinaka Vakalevu and Thank you all!








Irvine, CA to be Home of \$30 Million Stadium

Backed by Shah Rukh Khan and MLC

IRVINE, CA - The Shah Rukh Khan owned Knight Riders Group in partnership with Major League Cricket (MLC), USA's official franchise league and the City of Irvine have announced plans to construct build a world-class cricket venue on a 15acre parcel at Great Park with a seating capacity of 10,000. The project is expected to be around \$30 million. It is seen as a significant step considering the possibilities of cricket's inclusion at the 2028

"Our investment in MLC in America is based on our belief in the exciting future of cricket

> in the USA and is well-aligned to our strategy of establishing Knight Riders as a global brand in

T20 cricket. Plans to build a world-class cricket stadium in the greater Los Angeles area is exciting for us and MLC. This will no doubt have a transformational impact on one of the world's most iconic metropolitan areas," said KRG owner and Bollywood actorproducer Shah Rukh Khan.

The stadium plans include state-of-theart training facilities, locker rooms, luxury suites, dedicated parking, concessions, field lighting and an international-grade pitch to meet International Cricket Council accreditation and allow the venue to host the highest level of international cricket competitions.

USA Cricket is expected to bid for future men's and women's World Cup tournaments, with the 2024 Men's T20 World Cup already set to be co-hosted by the United States of America and the West Indies. If the ICC is successful in getting cricket to the 2028 Los Angeles Olympics, the stadium at Great Park would be seen as a centerpiece venue for the event in Southern California.

"MLC is committed to building outstanding infrastructure for cricket in key markets accessible to legions of cricketloving fans. We're grateful to the City of Irvine for agreeing to explore this development in the heart of Orange County. Great Park's position as a hub for community recreation and its array of first-class sports facilities makes it an ideal location for the potential addition of a venue serving the local cricket-loving community and the

broader Greater Los Angeles region with major international cricket events set to take place there," said Sameer Mehta and Vijay Srinivasan, Co-Founders, Major League Cricket.

The development would see a multimillion-dollar investment, with the internationally renowned architects HKS chosen to design the stadium in the Greater Los Angeles metropolitan area.

The Knight Riders Group is a founding investor in MLC and is working closely with MLC on various aspects related to the launch of the league in 2023.

KRG, owners of the Kolkata Knight Riders in the Indian Premier League and Trinbago Knight Riders (TKR) in the Caribbean Premier League, will bring significant experience from one of the most successful brands in global T20 cricket to building MLC.



Professor Reena Aggarwal Inspires Alumni Commits \$11Million to Georgetown Univ.

WASHINGTON, DC - More than a decade after providing seed capital to establish a financial markets and policy center at the McDonough School of Business at Georgetown University, Michael G and Robin Psaros are committing \$11 million to build the Psaros Center for Financial Markets and Policy.

The gift builds upon years of collaboration between Michael Psaros and his mentor Reena Aggarwal, Robert E. McDonough Professor of Finance, and director of the center.

Aggarwal and Psaros first met as professor and student in the 1980s. Psaros said that the ways in which Aggarwal taught complex concepts, rigorous analysis, and logic had a profound and lasting impact that opened up the interconnectivity of politics and policy on finance and business to him.

"I am very grateful to my mentor, Dr. Reena Aggarwal—one of the great minds in finance globally—for providing me with encouragement and support for nearly 35 years, since I was one of her students," Psaros said. "Dr. Aggarwal believed in me before I believed in myself."

After Psaros graduated and made a distinguished career in finance as co-founder and managing partner of KPS Capital Partners,

a leading global private equity firm, he became involved in Georgetown leadership, and he reconnected with Aggarwal over their shared interests.

"Mike was always interested in finance and policy," said Aggarwal. "That goes

back to when he was a student, and it has continued ever since. He understands both sides: why financial markets are important, and how policy can play a significant role."

When Aggarwal became interim dean and then deputy dean of Georgetown

McDonough, she interacted with Psaros frequently through his work on the Board. She regularly invited Psaros to speak with her students about his firm's constructive investing activities to drive transformational change of manufacturing companies.

Then, the financial crisis of 2008 hit, and the epicenter of financial policy decision-making moved from New York City to Washington, D.C. In the immediate aftermath, Aggarwal saw a need for leadership and expertise that Georgetown should meet.

"There was a real leadership void for the financial sector," Aggarwal says. "Regulators were very busy trying to figure out what to do with this financial crisis and executives at financial firms were trying to lay low because they were getting the blame. It seemed to me that it was our responsibility at Georgetown to step up and fill this leadership void."

She approached Psaros with her plan to create a center for unbiased expertise in financial markets and policy, and he provided the seed capital to make it possible. Psaros was thrilled to be part of the center's creation. Aggarwal is a longtime professor at Georgetown. After graduating from the Birla Institute of Technology and Science, Pilani, she got her doctorate from the University of Maryland.



Musk Ignores India Tesla Moves to Other Markets

NEW DELHI, (IANS) - While Union Ministers keep on making a beeline to Tesla CEO Elon Musk to come and manufacture electric cars in India, he is more interested in his \$44 billion Twitter acquisition rather than paying attention to what the Indian government has been reiterating now for months.

His utter disinterest in responding to several requests made by the Indian government, especially by Union Road Transport and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari, comes in the wake of reports that the team he hired in India last year has now been diverted to focus on the Middle East and the larger Asia-Pacific markets.

Nishant Prasad, in charge of establishing Tesla's supercharger network in India, has updated his LinkedIn profile to Charging Operations Lead-APAC.

Manoj Khurana, who was Tesla India's first recruit, responsible for public policy and business development, relocated to California last month to take up a product role.



The move by the Musk-led Tesla appears to be a retaliation as the Indian government has not accepted the demand by Musk to reduce import duties on Tesla vehicles. From Telangana Minister for Industries, KT Rama Rao, to Maharashtra Minister and state NCP President Jayant Patil, several Indian leaders have made repeated appeals to Musk to bring Tesla to India but to no avail.

During the 'Raisina Dialogue 2022' last month, Gadkari said that if Musk wants to manufacture in China and sell Tesla cars here, "it cannot be a good proposition for India". "India is a huge market and offers good export opportunities too. Musk can export Tesla cars from India," he told the audience. Asked about Tesla's demand to cut customs duties on electric cars, Gadkari said that the country cannot appease one automobile company. Musk had tweeted that he faced challenges from the government for releasing its products in India. "Tesla isn't in India yet due to "Challenges with the government", he posted.

James Murdoch Buys Stake in Indian Education Company for \$600 Mln

NEW DELHI, (IANS) -Bodhi Tree Systems, an investment platform by former 21st Century Fox CEO James Murdoch and ex-Disney executive Uday Shankar, on May 1 announced it would invest \$600 million in Allen Career Institute which has a pan-India footprint with a growing presence in the Middle East.

Founded by Rajesh Maheshwari in 1988, Allen is a premier coaching institute for the preparation of JEE, pre-medical, Classes 6 to 10, NTSE, and Olympiads.

The \$600 million investment will help Allen, which has 138 classroom centers in 46 cities in the country, empower millions of students in test-prep and K12 segments. "Allen's unrivalled success and scale provide the right foundation to build the digital education company of the future. We are excited to work with the Maheshwari family to build an outcomes-focused digital education company that delivers on the aspirations of millions of learners and parents in India and beyond,"



said Murdoch and Shankar in a joint statement.

"Our partnership with Bodhi Tree is an essential ingredient in furthering our mission to significantly increase Allen's reach and impact," he added.

The transaction is expected to close within three months and is subject to requisite approvals.

Bodhi Tree Systems is a newly formed platform between Lupa Systems Founder and CEO Murdoch and Shankar. Qatar Investment Authority (QIA), the sovereign wealth fund of the State of Qatar, is an investor in Bodhi Tree Systems.

Apple Sues IndianAmerican for Stealing Chip Secrets

SAN FRANCISCO, CA (IANS) - Apple has sued the Santa Clarabased "stealth-mode" semiconductor startup Rivos and two former employees, Indian American Bhasi Kaithamana and Ricky Wen, for allegedly stealing trade secrets to build a chip lineup.

In a lawsuit filed in CA, the iPhone maker said that Rivos launched a "coordinated campaign" to attract Apple employees and encourage them to copy confidential documents before quitting. Apple employed Kaithamana for nearly 8 years, from September 2013 until August 2021.

"During his tenure with Apple, Kaithamana was a CPU implementation engineer, responsible for managing CPU design for Apple's SoCs (system on chips)," the lawsuit said.

Osmania and Rutgers University graduate Kaithamana was responsible for, among other things, designing and developing proprietary and trade secret physical structures for carrying out critical functions in Apple's ARM-based SoCs. The lawsuit alleged that before leaving Apple in August 2021, Kaithamana copied a series of spreadsheets, presentations, and text files onto an external USB drive under the name "APPLE_WORK_DOCS".

Wen also allegedly accessed files related to Apple trade secrets, including "files related to Apple's unreleased SoC designs, and then made a copy of his companyissued computer's hard drive just before leaving the company".

"The sheer volume of information taken, the highly sensitive nature of that information, and the fact that these employees are now performing the same duties for a competitor with ongoing access to some of Apple's most valuable trade secrets, leave Apple with few alternatives," the lawsuit read.

The TX based Rivos was founded in May 2021 to design a full stack computing solution based on custom-designed reduced instruction set computer-based SoCs that will compete with Apple's ARM SoCs.

"Since June 2021, over 40 former Apple employees have joined Rivos. Rivos continues to target Apple engineers, with more departures occurring this month. Most of these former Apple employees were design engineers, developing Apple's cutting-edge proprietary and trade secret SoC designs," said Apple in its lawsuit.

The lawsuit alleged that Rivos encouraged employees to copy troves of work-related documents before leaving. "Rivos began a coordinated campaign to target Apple employees with access to Apple proprietary and trade secret information about Apple's SoC designs," the lawsuit claimed.

Many of the employees who left Apple to join Rivos were "trusted by Apple with its most sensitive trade secret SoC designs and technology". "Many have taken Apple's proprietary and trade secret information with them," said the company, which is also asking for monetary damages.

IBM CEO Arvind Krishna Elected to NY Fed Board

NEW YORK, NY- The Federal Reserve Bank of New York on May 3 announced that IBM Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Dr. Arvind Krishna has been elected to its board. 60-year-old Krishna has been elected as a Class B Director, "representing the public with due but not exclusive consideration to the interests of agriculture, commerce, industry, services, labor, and consumers."

Krishna has degrees from IIT, Kanpur and the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

The New York Fed said in a statement that Arvind Krishna will fill the vacancy in the office for the remaining portion of a three-year term ending December 31, 2023.



"In his current and former roles, Krishna has led the building and expansion of new markets for IBM in cloud, artificial intelligence, blockchain, and quantum computing. He has also played a significant role in the development of innovative IBM products and solutions based on these emerging technologies," the statement added.

Richard Verma on Biden's Intelligence Advisory Board



WASHINGTON, DC (IANS) – President Joe Biden has named Indian American Richard Verma, a former ambassador to India, to a White House body that advises the president on the effectiveness of the country's sprawling intelligence community.

Biden also named retired Admiral James A. "Sandy" Winnefeld as chair of the body – President's Intelligence Advisory Board, – and Janet Napolitano, a former secretary of the department of homeland security and Gilman G. Louie as members, like Verma.

The White House said the advisory board serves as an independent element within the executive office of the and that it exists exclusively to assist the president by providing him with an "independent source of advice

on the effectiveness with which the intelligence community is meeting the nation's intelligence needs and the vigor and insight with which the community plans for the future".

Verma is currently with Mastercard as its general counsel and head of global public policy. He was sent to India as ambassador by President Barack Obama in 2014 – he was the first Indian American to be named US ambassador to India. He had earlier served in the state department as assistant secretary of state and National Security Advisor to the Senate Majority Leader.

Verma was an active member of Biden's 2020 presidential campaign and led the team's outreach to the Indian American community.

Nand Mulchandani Named Chief Technology Officer of CIA

WASHINGTON, DC (IANS) - Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) Director William J. Burns has announced the appointment of Nand Mulchandani to serve as the US spy agency's first-ever Chief Technology Officer (CTO).

With more than 25 years' experience working in Silicon Valley as well as the Department of Defense (DoD), Mulchandani brings substantial private sector, startup, and government expertise the CIA said in a statement.

As the CTO, Mulchandani will ensure the Agency is leveraging cutting-edge innovations and scanning the horizon for tomorrow's innovations to further CIA's mission. "Since my confirmation, I have prioritized focusing on technology and the new CTO position is a very important part of that effort. I am delighted Nand has joined our team and will bring his extensive experience to this crucial new role," said Burns.

Prior to joining CIA, Mulchandani most recently served as the CTO and Acting Director of DoD's Joint Artificial Intelligence Center. He also co-founded and was CEO of several successful startups Oblix (acquired by Oracle), Determina (acquired by VMWare), OpenDNS (acquired by Cisco), and



ScaleXtreme (acquired by Citrix).

He has a degree in Computer Science and Math from Cornell University, a Master of Science degree in Management from Stanford University and a Master in Public Administration degree from Harvard University.

She has previously had assignments at the US Embassy in Kuwait and the US Consulate General in Mumbai. She was the Consul General and Principal Officer of the US Consulate in Dharan, Saudi Arabia.

She also led the Management

Section of the US Embassy in Colombo, and, in Washington, she served as a Special Assistant to the Under Secretary for Management.

Among her other assignments, Korhonen was the Supervisory General Services Officer and Senior Human Resources Officer at the US Embassy in Riyadh, and the Political Chief of the Provincial Reconstruction Team in Kirkuk, Iraq. Indian Americans Break With India on Ukraine

Indian American speakers could include the four serving members of the US House of Representatives Ami Bera, Pramila Jayapal, Ro Khanna, and Raja Krishnamoorthi, all of whom have been extremely critical of the Russian invasion and both publicly and privately critical of India's refusal to condemn it.

Politically active Indian Americans have been a key driver of the India-US relationship. They helped soften American backlash against India after the 1998 Pokhran II nuclear tests and, most significantly, rallied US lawmakers to pass a legislation that ended India's nuclear isolation in 2008.

They have stood with the Indian government of the day in a notable display of bipartisan solidarity with their country of origin. And Prime Minister Narendra Modi has been popular with both Republican and Democratic Indian Americans. For the community to break so publicly with his government's position on Ukraine should cause concern at 7 Race Course Road. Like most Americans, Indian Americans have been horrified by Russia's invasion of Ukraine in February and have been appalled by images of death and destruction coming out of the battle-ravaged country.

They have also watched with growing disquiet the Modi government's refusal to condemn the invasion and bristle at having to "either defend it or face scorn for it". One Indian American said he was asked by a Pennsylvania party official recently, "Why is India supporting the Russians?"

India is not supporting the Russian invasion. While it has refused to condemn it outrightly, it has made clear its opposition to it. New Delhi has called for the immediate cessation of hostilities and that the sovereignty and territorial integrity of nations must be respected. But all of that has been obscured by India abstaining in critical UN votes on the war.

"What the Russian Army has been doing in Ukraine is downright genocide," said Shekhar Tiwari, a Republican operative who is also chairman of the American Hindu Coalition. He has been a close associate of several top BJP leaders. "Being a Hindu and a son of a Gandhian, it is hard for me to stomach," he added.

These Indian Americans are careful not to criticize the Indian government and insist they only want to express their horror over situation in Ukraine, which they described as a "genocide", as has US President Joe Biden.

They have been concerned about the blowback they are getting for India's position on the war and believe a public denouncement of Russia will, one,



make clear the community feels as revolted as the rest of the country. And two, that the community is "not in the pocket of the embassy", as one these Indian Americans put it. Breaking with the Indian government over the Ukraine war will serve the twin purposes of signaling their own independence from the govern-

ment of India and, two, convey their own feelings on the issue.

Some Indian Americans have also argued, since Russia invaded Ukraine in February, India needs to denounce Moscow and finally

pick a side that will be strategically more meaningful. Ramesh Kapur, a Democratic strategist who worked closely with the presidential campaign of Biden, says India's refusal to condemn the Russian invasion could be problematic should it need US assistance in a conflict with China. "If India gets

into a situation with China, it can expect support from the US, but if the US thinks it cannot count on India they will have a problem." he said, taking a tactical view of India's position, as has been put forth by many US lawmakers. Congressman Khanna told Fox News in March that he thinks India "ought to be condemning Putin" and "they need to realize, they have to pick sides". He had added: "We, the United States, were with them when China invaded India. Putin wasn't there. And it's time for them to buy weapons from the United States, not Russia. We've got to look at how we can facilitate that and make that easier. We need India as an ally ultimately to contain China."

the community she served. In April 2009 Out magazine named her one of the 50 most influential LGBT people in the US.

Vaid was the founder of LPAC, the first lesbian Super PAC, which was launched in July 2012 and as of 2020 has invested millions of dollars in candidates who are committed to legislation promoting social justice. She was founder of The Vaid Group, a social innovation consultancy that advises individuals and organizations working

to advance equity, justice, and inclusion globally and domestically. Vaid had served as Executive Director of the National LGBTQ Task Force from 1989-1992. The current officeholder Kierra Johnson, in a statement summed up the feelings of many in a statement, "We are devastated at the loss of one of the most influential progressive activists of our time," and added, "Urvashi Vaid was a leader, a warrior and a force to be reckoned with. She was also a beloved colleague, friend, partner, and someone we all looked up to - a brilliant, outspoken, and deeply committed activist who wanted full justice and equality for all people."

Another former Executive Director Rea Carey posted, "I am deeply sad that Urvashi Vaid has died. My heart is with Kate and all of Urv's beloveds who have been with her these last years, months,

and days as she dealt with cancer. My activism has been greatly shaped by the fact that Urv took me seriously as a young leader in our movement. She seemed endlessly excited about the ideas and passion for justice that young activists held. She was one of our movement's motivators and north stars."

Kate Clinton, a comedian, was Vaid's longtime partner and specializes in political commentary from a gay and lesbian perspective. Vaid held degrees from Vassar College and Northeastern University School of Law. The Indian American attorney was also an author having published, 'Virtual Equality: The Mainstreaming of Gay and Lesbian Liberation' and 'Irresistible Revolution: Confronting Race, Class and the Assumptions of LGBT Politics.'Vaid was the aunt of activist and performance artist Alok Vaid-Menon.

Indian Americans Furious Racist Upenn Prof Calls India "Sh**Hole"

PHILADELPHIA, PA - Congressman Raja Krishnamoorthi is among the Indian Americans taking umbrage University of Pennsylvania professor Amy Wax for her comments about the Asian American community, while specifically disparaging Indian Americans.

In an interview to the ultra-conservative talk show host Tucker Carlson on Fox News she made more inflammatory comments, slamming immigrants who are critical of the US. "There is just a tremendous amount of resentment and shame of non-western peoples against western peoples for western peoples' outsized achievements and contributions. It's really unbearable."

Wax singled out Asian and South Asian Indian doctors at Penn Medicine, who she said, "Are on the ramparts for the antiracism initiative for dump in America."

She focused on Brahmin women from India. "Here's the problem," she said. "They are taught that they are better than everybody else because they are Brahmin elites and yet on some level, their country is a s-hole. ... They've realized that we've outgunned and outclassed them in every way. ... They feel anger. They feel envy. They feel shame. ... It creates ingratitude of the most monstrous kind."

"After President Trump left office, I thought the days of calling others "sh**hole" countries were over," Krishnamoorthi said in a tweet. "As an Indian-American immigrant, I'm disgusted to hear this UPenn Professor define Indian-American immigrants, and all non-white Americans, in such insulting terms," he said. "Comments like these are borne of hatred and fear, and they lead to real harm for my constituents and our minority communities. They fuel hate crimes



against minorities, and they make it much harder to accomplish common-sense immigration reform," Krishnamoorthi said. Indian American Law professor Neil Makhija also slammed Wax for her comments.

"It's irresponsible to use your position to lend credibility to these overtly racist sentiments that don't recognize Indian-Americans for who we are," he told Axios.

Indian American Impact is slated to hold a summit next month in Washington DC, and Makjiha told Axios he's planning to adjust programming to discuss the incident and create solutions against anti-Asian and South Asian hate in educational settings.

"The most unfortunate thing is that we have a lot of brilliant and incredible students

at the law school," he told NBC News. "It makes you question whether she can fairly grade or educate," he said.

This is not the first time Wax has made controversial comments about race. Her appearance on Carlson's show is also not the first time Wax has made anti-Asian remarks.

In an interview in December, she said that Indians Americans should be more "grateful" to be in the US and that the country would be "better off with fewer Asians."

Meanwhile a representative at UPenn told the media, "The University of Pennsylvania Carey Law School has previously made clear that Professor Wax's views do not reflect our values or practices," adding actions were being discussed.

WASHINGTON, DC - A subcommittee of the U.S. House Energy and Commerce Committee on May 11, voted to advance the South Asian Heart Health Awareness and Research Act.

South Asian Heart Health

The critical legislation will provide grants of up to \$1 million per year to fund research and prevention of heart disease in South Asian communities.

South Asian Americans are four times more likely to suffer from heart disease than most people and experience heart problems nearly a decade earlier on average.

While South Asians make up only 23% of the global population, they account for 60% of all heart disease cases. And, tragically, the mortality rate for heart disease is a staggering 40% higher among South Asians.

Indian American Impact Executive Director Neil Makhija said it was, "a crucial piece of legislation for addressing the heart health crisis afflicting South Asian communities."

Indian American Congresswoman Pramila Jayapal who has said she is committed to the bipartisan bill to help raise awareness in the South Asian community and ensuring that those living with heart disease have access to treatment, resources and support, was thanked by Makhija. "We are grateful to Representative Jayapal for her leadership and advocacy in addressing this major problem in our communities, and look forward to bipartisan passage in the House, followed by swift adoption in the Senate," he said in a statement.

'Sikh Independence' **CTStatementCondemned**

NEW YORK, NY - The Indian Consulate General in New York has condemned a statement by the Connecticut State General will meet the legislators behind the statement and explain the situation. He deplored the statement calling it "terrible".

It said that the Consulate and the Embassy in Washington "will take up this issue appropriately with the concerned US lawmakers". The Consulate said that the adoption of the General Assembly's statement "is an attempt by some mischievous elements to use the name of the Assembly for their nefarious purposes. These vested interests seek to divide communities and promote bigotry and hatred".

"Their agenda of violence has no place in democratic societies like the USA and India."

Thomas Abraham, the Chairman of the Global Organization of People of Indian Origin said that the group's Connecticut chapter

got it adopted at the tail-end of the Assembly session without the knowledge of most elected officials". The statement attributed to the Democratic Party-controlled State General Assembly comprising both the House of Representatives and the Senate was read out at a ceremony in front of the Norwich City Hall on April 29, according to a video by TV84, a New York Punjabi online media.

"Connecticut General Assembly offers its sincerest congratulations to the World Sikh Parliament in recognition of the 36th anniversary of the declaration of Sikh Independence", said the statement purportedly signed by Senate President Pro-tem Mark Looney, Speaker Matthew Ridder, and Secretary of State Denise Merril, according to the video.

The World Sikh Parliament is a Khalistani organization.

As of May 1, the General Assembly statement could not be found in its online records or on the websites of legislators who could have sponsored it.





The US Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF) has recommended this designation for 15 countries in its annual report for 2022 released on April 25.

Ten of them were declared countries of particular concern by the State Department in 2021 -- Myanmar, China, Eritrea, Iran, North Korea, Pakistan, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Tajikistan and Turkmenistan. The rest were Afghanistan, India, Nigeria, Syria and Vietnam.

The USCIRF report also rec-

pecially religious minorities and those reporting on and advocating for them -- through harassment, investigation, detention, and prosecution under laws such as the Unlawful Activities Prevention Act (UAPA) and the Sedition Law."

The USCIRF is an independent, bipartisan US federal government agency created by the 1998 International Religious Freedom Act. It monitors the state of religious freedom around the world and makes policy recommendations to the president, secretary of state and congress.



ommended in the case of India that the US should impose "targeted sanctions on individuals and entities responsible for severe violations of religious freedom by freezing those individuals' or entities' assets and/or barring their entry into the United States". In 2021, the report said in its key findings, "The Indian government escalated its promotion and enforcement of policies -- including those promoting a Hindu-nationalist agenda -- that negatively affected Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Dalits, and other religious minorities. The government continued to systemize its ideological vision of a Hindu state at both the national and state levels through the use of both existing and new laws and structural changes hostile to the country's religious minorities".

The report added: "In 2021, the Indian government repressed critical voices -- es-

The USCIRF had made the same recommendation for India -- to be declared a country of particular concern -- in 2021 as well, but it was not accepted. The commission's recommendations are not binding on the US government or the Congress. The State Department compiles its own international religious freedom report every year.

"We are disheartened by the deterioration of freedom of religion or belief in some countries, especially Afghanistan under the Taliban's de facto government since August. Religious minorities have faced harassment, detention, and even death due to their faith or beliefs, and years of progress toward more equitable access to education and representation of women and girls have disappeared," USCIRF Chair Nadine Maenza said in a statement announcing the release of the 2022 report.

Poll: Indians Support Taking in Refugees, Want Ties With Russia



NEW DELHI, (IANS) - A survey conducted by Ipsos to capture the response to the war in Ukraine found seven in 10 urban Indians support taking in Ukrainian refugees. Eight in 10 want India to avoid getting militarily involved. Six in 10 want India to continue diplomatic ties with Russia.

Ipsos Public Affairs is a nonpartisan survey-based research group. There is a high level of interest in keeping abreast of the news with seven in 10 urban Indians polled saying they have been following the stories emerging on the conflict.

72 percent of urban Indians polled support taking in refugees, while 79 percent reject India's military involvement/ intervention in the conflict. Notably, 62 percent of urban Indians polled

support India continuing its diplomatic ties with Russia.

Interestingly, urban Indians believe the ongoing conflict impacts the world the most (82 percent), it impacts India to a lesser extent (72 percent), it impacts their job/ business (61 percent), is affecting them personally (56 percent), and their family (52 percent) to some extent.

Interestingly, Indian views are in alignment with the global view of giving sanctuary to Ukrainian refugees but desisting from military action. Most respondents, global citizens (61 percent) and urban Indians (74 percent) reject providing financial aid to Ukraine, given the tough economic situation faced by most.

Where they differ is in Russia ties. Though 62 percent of urban Indians want diplomatic ties with

Russia to continue, globally only 38 percent support it.

Indians support sanctions to end the war and reject direct punitive action by India against Russia.

Seven in 10 Indians believe doing nothing in Ukraine will embolden Russia to take the war to the rest of Europe and Asia. However, very few Indians support economic sanctions by India on Russia (only 4 in 10), banning of oil & gas imports from Russia (4 in 10), giving weapons to Ukraine (only 38 percent agree), funding to Ukrainian military (only 4 in 10 support) and less support for sending troops to NATO or Ukraine, among Indians (about 39 percent).

These are the findings of a 27-country Ipsos survey conducted March 25 - April 3 among 19,000 adults aged 18-74.

India Could be Helping Military Equipment Reach Russia

NEW DELHI, (IANS)- Russian friendly countries, including India, could be helping Western manufactured components to make their way into Russian weapons used in Ukraine, British defense and security think tank --Royal United Services Institute --said in a report.

The report, titled "Operation Z: The Death Throes of an Imperial Delusion", published two weeks ago, stated the Russian military equipment found in Ukraine contain foreign-made components prohibited under embargoes.

"Russia's modern military hardware is dependent upon complex



electronics imported from the US, the UK, Germany, the Netherlands, Japan, Israel, China and further afield."

Without an assured supply chain to manufacture more, the Russians are having to retain a large proportion of the stockpile, which would restrict their ability to strike Ukraine in the coming months. But here the Russian military industries face a problem, for Russia's latest weapons are heavily dependent upon critical specialist components manufactured abroad. Technical inspection of Russian weapons and vehicles, conducted by the Central Scientific Research Institute for Armaments of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, reveals that there is a consistent pattern across all major Russian weapons systems recovered from the battlefield.

Examples are the 9M949 guided 300-mm rocket that forms the backbone of Russian precision artillery as a munition for the Tornado-S multiple launch rocket system uses a US-made fiberoptic gyroscope for its inertial navigation.54.

The Russian TOR-M2 air-defense system, one of the most potent short-ranged air-defense systems in the world, relies on

a British-designed oscillator in the computer controlling the platform's radar. Other critical electronic components are manufactured in Germany, the Netherlands, South Korea and Japan, the report stated.

Although Russian weapons are full of Western manufactured components, it is not clear that the company's manufacturing them knew that the Russian military was the end-user. In some instances, these components are civilian dual-use electronics that can be procured commercially. Restricting access, therefore, likely means preventing export to countries such as India of goods that are in some instances used for civilian purposes. "This would, unfortunately, strengthen the Russian argument that the West is prepared to inflict economic pain around the world for the sake of punishing Russia and, in doing so, reduce compliance with Western sanctions. Russia is also prepared to use blackmail to keep these channels open."

Meanwhile, Russia has established mechanisms for laundering these items through third countries. This channel is now increasingly constrained. But there are many others.

India's Neighborhood: Anti-China Sentiments Developing

NEW DELHI, (ANI) -Ever since Beijing started implementing its expansionist policies and crushing the voices of dissidents, the feeling of resistance is fast developing in its neighboring countries and occupied territories like Xinjiang and Tibet.

PAKISTAN

Although neighboring Pakistan is China's close ally, the people here are raising their voices against Beijing for its continuous exploitation of resources and violating human rights. The Chinese working in Pakistan are facing resistance and being attacked. On April 24 three Chinese nationals and a local man were killed outside the University of Karachi's Confucius Institute. The suicide attack was carried out by the Baloch Liberation Army, which opposes Chinese investment in their territory. The China-Pakistan Economic Corridor, one of the six limbs of China's Silk Road Economic Belt has been criticized as a form of colonization, that will doom Islamabad into being a vassal of Beijing. Pakistan Navy must vacate 20 acres of prime land in Gwadar to facilitate China over its own security.

MYANMAR

In Myanmar, the National Unity Government has also warned China that its engagement with the country's military Junta could seriously damage China's international reputation, just days after China's foreign minister pledged Beijing's support for the military. The NUG stated that it was committed to good relations with China, but that this had to be constructed based on the NUG as the legitimate government of Myanmar.



SRI LANKA

Sri Lanka's economic instability is largely caused by China's debt-trap diplomacy. Defaults over China's infrastructure-related loans to Sri Lanka, especially the financing of the Hambantota Port, are being cited as factors contributing to the crisis. The construction of the Hambantota Port was financed by the Chinese Exim Bank. The Port was running into losses, so Sri Lanka leased out the Port for 99 years to the Chinese Merchant's Group, which paid Sri Lanka \$1.12 billion. According to World Bank estimates, five lakh people in Sri Lanka have fallen below the poverty line since the onset of the crisis. As Sri Lanka faces its worst economic crisis in decades and struggles to pay loans, China turns a blind eye after ensnaring the island nation into a debt trap. Total debt to China stands at \$8 billion, almost one-sixth of Sri Lanka's total external debt of \$45 billion.



NEPAL

China's relations with Nepal are also weakening. In January, Nepal Airlines grounded six Chinese-made aircraft, saying that it was proving to be unaffordable to fly them. These sub-standard planes delivered extremely poor serviceability rates and required heavy maintenance. The loan from China for these aircraft has, however, continued to haunt the airlines. Dues worth \$35.1 million, at a steep interest rate along with a service charge and management expenses, are still pending.

BANGLADESH

China's supply of sub-standard military equipment to Bangladesh has also irked the Muslim majority nation. The Bangladesh military imported two submarines of 1970s vintage and frigates from China, with its import dependence on Chinese hardware touching nearing 85 percent. Beijing gifted two 1970s-era submarines to Bangladesh valued at \$100 million each in 2017. However, both the platforms have been lying idle due to technical issues.



Honorable mentions in the Short Film category went to Megha Ramaswamy's 'Lalanna's Song,' and Akanksha Cruczynski's 'Close Ties to Home Country.' The Audience Choice Award for Best Short went to the irresistible '7 Star Dinosor Entertainment' by Vaishali Naik.

The Feature Films Jury included Lakshmi Iyengar (Executive Vice President, Minor Realm); Smriti Mundhra (Academy Award nominee, Director, St. Louis Superman); and Jonathan Wysocki (Director, Dramarama). The Short Films Jury comprised of Geetika Lizardi (Writer, Bridgerton, Mira, Royal Detective); Sid Mehra (Manager of Development and Production, Endeavor Content); and Carey Williams (Director, Emergency, R#J).

Highlights of this year's landmark 20th Anniversary edition of IFFLA, a press release said, included the Opening Night Gala presentation of Pan Nalin's 'Last Film Show,' the inauguration of the new Spotlight on South Asia section, a virtual 20th Anniversary Shorts special program celebrating the festival's history, a Master Class with Anurag Kashyap, and the film festival's annual One-on-One program where filmmakers were paired with a series of industry executives.




