
Anurag Chandra Of Corona Found **Guilty Of Murdering Three Teens**

RIVERSIDE, CA (IANS) - The man charged with ramming his car into a vehicle resulting in the deaths of three teens who were fleeing after one of them allegedly exposed himself at his house as a prank, has been found guilty.

Anurag Chandra, 45, was convicted in a court here on April 28 on three charges of murder in the deaths of three teens and attempted murder for the three teens who survived after their car was hit by his.

In January 2020, the group of teens were playing a prank and picked Chandra's home in the city of Corona as they thought teens lived there. One of them rang the

WASHINGTON, DC (IANS) - President Joe Biden has picked Indian-American Neera Tanden to serve as Assistant to the President and Domestic Policy Advisor, following former Ambassador Susan Rice's exit from that role.

Tanden, who currently serves as Senior Advisor to President Biden and Staff Secretary, will be the first Asian-American to lead any of the three major White House policy councils in history.

"I am pleased to announce that Neera Tanden will continue to drive the formulation and implementation of my domestic policy, from economic mobility and racial equity to

This will now move the California Caste Bill SB 403 forward to the Senate. If passed, the bill introduced by State Senator Aisha Wahab, the first Muslim and Afghan American elected to the state legislature, would make California

Lecture Explores The Ganges & Human-Environment Realtions Through Time



Speaker Dr. Sudipta Sen at the Yadunandan Center in Long Beach

LONG BEACH, CA - The Yadunandan Center for India Studies at California State University, Long Beach, on April 17, held the 23rd annual Solanki Lecture, the longest-running endowed lecture series about the history and culture of South Asia and the South Asian diaspora in the US.

This year's speaker was Dr. Sudipta Sen, Professor of History at UC Davis, winner of the William Jones Memorial Medal from the Asiatic Society, and author of two major works about the history of India's colonial period as well as the popular book Ganges: The Many Pasts of an Indian River.

the ecologies of the Ganges delta. Through maps and photographs, accounts of travelers, and scholars, the audience learned how this vast constellation of low-lying jungles, lakes, channels, marshes, swamps, and mangroves has changed over time. He then talked about the lesser-known histories and lifeworlds of the people who have adapted their lives in relation to the species, weather patterns, and ocean tides of the region. His provocative lecture reconceptualized the periodization of climate change in the past while laying out how these populations remain the foremost victims and survivors of the climate change crisis in the present.

Will Abortion Be The Wedge Issue In 2024?

eventy-five percent of voters say omen and their doctors should decide; just nine percent say judges and politicians should decide.

Polls were clear before and after the 2022 midterm election. A large majority of Americans think abortion should be legal. More than any other issue, abortion rights brought people out to vote in the last election.

"The Supreme Court's decision a few months before the 2022 midterm elections was political suicide," said Suba Srinivasaraghavan, a field organizer with They See Blue in Virginia.

After the decision, she saw a surge in volunteering forget-out-the-vote initiatives. "More people said, 'yes' to field organizers, to not just go out and vote, but also to volunteer, to write cards, knock on doors and to donate to many campaigns," Srinivasaraghavan said.

"Abortion all of a sudden became front and center for many constituents and candidates alike," she added.

During a national briefing by Ethnic Media Services, five organizers explained why reproductive rights a top issue in the 2024 Presidential Election would be.

"Voters across the country and across the political spectrum said, 'Enough is enough.' And in every state where abortion was on the ballot, voters supported protecting and expanding access," said Angela Vasquez-Giroux, Pro-Choice America's Vice President of Communications and Research.

A poll conducted by Impact Research don't have after the midterm election, found that abortion has the power to continue to funds they drive votes in future elections. A majority (52%) of voters are concerned that Republicans will try to ban abortion care, including 74% of Black voters and 53% of for abortion non-Democrats who voted Democratic in care. the midterms. A plurality (48%) said they are less likely to support Republicans if they attempt to ban abortion care.

Lupe Rodriguez, National Executive Director, Latina Institute for Reproductive Justice, noted that abortion care has never been accessible for women of color. "Antiabortion politicians have been working for decades to make abortion difficult to get, and the continued attacks on abortion access fall hardest on communities of color and people working to make ends meet," she said.

"The Dobbs decision has been yet another blow to AAPI women seeking abortion care by creating a landscape where states have tonomy and the right to choose to say they been emboldened to enact their own abortion restrictions or bans," Hsu said.

Hsu noted that cultural, economic, and logistical barriers for AAPI community members, especially those working in frontline service jobs, make traveling and getting an abortion often difficult, if not impossible.

"These impacts on the AAPI community have fueled NAPAWF's work galvanizing Asian American women voters in critical states like Florida, Georgia, and Texas," she said.

Currently, battles continue in several states about access to medication abortions. According to the Guttmacher Institute, a two-drug combination of mifepristone and misoprostol accounted for more than half of all facility-based abortions in 2020.

A Texas lawsuit could stop access to abortion pills nationwide if it succeeds in reversing the FDA's approval of mifepristone. In North Carolina and West Virginia

Abortion rights advocates have filed lawsuits challenging restrictions on access to abortion pills. "Our partners across the country are faced with ensuring their communities have access to reproductive healthcare including, safe and affordable abortion care, while also responding to other community needs," said Ebony Baylor, Vice President of Government Affairs, In Our and Pacific Islanders find themselves in a Own Voice: National Black Women's Reproductive Justice Agenda.

> Baylor said Black women do not live single-issue lives and when thinking about who best represents them, they consider many factors.

Ebony Baylor, VP of Government Affairs, In Our Own Voice: National Black Women's Reproductive Justice Agenda, says denying women, especially Black women, access to abortion care will worsen America's already high maternal mortality rate.

"Our civil and human rights are being attacked from all sides - lack of access to health care, clean water, childcare, social justice, and more are all things Black women think about when facing crucial decisions about their lives, families, and communities," she said.

Access to the ballot box remains a big issue for Black women voters, says Baylor. "Voter suppression and subversion laws are being introduced by elected leaders in state houses across the country at an alarming rate," she said.

How significant will reproductive rights be in 2024? Baylor noted that Black voters are not single-issue voters, but abortion rights are going to be an important issue.

"It's going to be a deciding factor," she (Ethnic Media Services)



the country's first state to make caste bias illegal by adding it as a protected category in the state's anti-discrimination laws.

Over a hundred California Dalits testified before the committee and spoke of bias, exclusion, and violence they've experienced at the hands of what they said was meted out to them by caste-privileged coworkers and bosses. In all, between the live testimony and phone calls, a little over 200 people said they support the bill and over 400 said they oppose it.

Equality Labs, the brain behind the anti-caste discrimination resolution in Seattle, WA, has been spearheading a nationwide campaign. Seattle became the first US city to outlaw caste discrimination in February.

Thenmozhi Soundararajan founder of Equality Labs told the media, "Today, I proudly stand in solidarity with my caste-oppressed community members, caste equity movement organizers, and allies to say that caste-oppressed Californians are now one step closer to attaining the protections they deserve and are entitled to."

The protestors at the hearing were vociferous too. Several

Association, the largest hotel owner's association in the US with 20,000 members strongly opposed it. Kalpesh Joshi, a Board Member, said "We believe that it will disproportionately impact Indian hotel and motel owners."

Vipul Patel, president of Asian American Shop Owners Association, representing over 8,300 stores, said, "We fear that this bill, if passed, will encourage frivolous lawsuits against small businesses, causing many of them to go out of business." Tejal Shah, convenor of the Hindu Mandir Executives' Conference, an umbrella organization of Hindu temples in North

America, said the organizations and individuals behind the bill have made their disdain for Hindu customs and traditions very clear.

Led by the Coalition of Hindus of North America, over 100 other organizations said the bill targets South Asians, along with other people of color such as those from other regions. "If passed, the bill violates the civil rights of South Asians and other people of color and denies them equal protection and due process," it said.



people were on the sidewalks holding signs against the bill. Many referred to what had transpired earlier this month, when the California Civil Rights Department voluntarily dismissed its case alleging caste discrimination against two Cisco engineers, Sundar Iyer and Ramana Kompella. The litigation against the Silicon Valley tech giant remains though. Several Indian business groups and temples issued a joint statement against it.







was initially nominated by Biden to head the Office of Management and Budget but her nomination was withdrawn earlier this year as it did not seem like she would be confirmed by the Senate.

She served in both the Obama and Clinton administrations, as well as presidential campaigns and think tanks. Most recently, Tanden was the President and CEO of the Center for American Progress and the Center for American Progress Action Fund.

Tanden previously served as senior advisor for health reform

at the Department of Health and Human Services, working on President Barack Obama's health reform team in the White House.

Prior to that, she was the director of domestic policy for the Obama-Biden presidential campaign, and served as policy director for the Hillary Clinton presidential campaign. She was a key architect of the Affordable Care Act and helped drive key domestic policies that became part of Biden's agenda, including clean energy subsidies and sensible gun reform. She received her bachelor of science from UCLA and her law degree from Yale Law School.

Musk Settles Defamation Suit Brought By Student

CA (IANS) Tesla CEO Elon Musk has agreed to pay \$10,000 to settle a defamation case brought against him by Randeep

Hothi. Hothi is a doctoral student in Asian Languages and Cultures at the University of

Michigan but lives in Northern California according to several reports, had filed a defamation case against Musk in 2020, alleging that the billionaire businessman falsely accused him of actively harassing and "almost killing" Tesla employees.

Following lengthy and hardfought litigation, in March 2023, Musk asked Hothi to settle the case.

"This case was about taking a stand, not seeking fame or money. I feel vindicated," said Hothi, announcing that he accepted Musk's settlement offer in a statement.

"I brought this case to defend my work, clear my name, and send a message... I believe I've accomplished that, thanks in no small part to Musk, whose own behavior over the last year has highlighted the need to scrutinize his every defamation lawsuit. word and deed."

D. Gill Sperlein, one of Hothi's lawyers, said: "Last year, Musk famously ing that Hothi "has demonstrated an unjust case'. Yet, he has asked Hothi to accommodate him. We welcome Musk's belated acknowledgment that this case was just."

Demographic Dividend: Population Shrinks In South India, North And East Balloons

NEW YORK, NY (IANS) - While the population ages and its growth shrinks in the southern states of India, labor migration from the northern and eastern states will make up for it, and the "demographic dividend" will continue there, according to the UN.

A paper from the UN's Department of Economic and Social Affairs , "India Overtakes China as the World's Most Populous Country", released on April 25, noted the divergences between states.

Explaining the differences within India, the paper said: "Under India's federal structure, state governments were able to set their own policy priorities, resulting in varied impacts across different parts of the country... In Kerala and Tamil Nadu, where state governments emphasized socio-economic development and women's empowerment,

fertility declined earlier and at a more rapid pace, falling below the replacement level two decades before the country.

"Those states that invested less in human capital, especially for girls and women, experienced slower reductions in fertility, despite controversial mass sterilization campaigns and other coercive measures in some locations."

While the overall fertility rate for the country has fallen to 2, which is below the 2.1 replacement rate.

The replacement rate of fertility is the number of children a woman must have to keep the population stabilized and fewer than that would mean a gradual reduction in population, which is happening in China with a 1.2 fertility rate as India has overtaken it to become the most populous country.

They range from 1.4 for Tamil Nadu and West

Bengal to 3 for Bihar among the large states, with Kerala at 1.5, according to the Indian Census Organization's Sample Registration System report released last year.

But the UN report said that overall, in India, the demographic dividend of a relatively younger and bigger working-age population "is projected to continue increasing both in number and as a proportion of the total population through mid-century".

The paper said that according to the UN's latest projections, "India's population is expected to reach its peak size around 2064 and then to decline gradually" after having passed 1.67 billion in 2050.

John Wilmoth, Director of the Population Division said, "A lot is made out of this demographic dividend, but it's really only one piece of the puzzle in terms of what contributes to economic growth and what can help countries as they are developing."

This is the time when countries should focus "on educating their populations and enabling people to participate in the labor force", he said, as they prepare for a slower population growth and a bigger older population.


Indian Illegals Second Largest Group Crossing English Channel LONDON, (IANS) - The number of

LONDON, (IANS) - The number of Indians illegally crossing over into the UK across the English Channel has increased sharply in the first three months of the year, making them the second biggest cohort after Afghans, according to the latest Home Office statistics.

Between January 1 and March 31, 2023, the most common nationality arriving via small boat was Afghans (24 percent) followed by Indians (18 percent), the new data revealed. The top five nationalities now illegally crossing the Channel in small boats include Afghanistan, India, Iran, Iraq, and Syria.

While the final statistics are due to be published on May 25 this year, a last month's Home Office data showed 683 Indians arriving in the country on small boats in 2022, as compared to 67 in 2021.

In February this year, Indians allegedly became the third-largest group of migrants entering UK shores illegally after Afghans and Syrians, The Times report said citing home Office sources.



According to the US Immigration and Customs Enforcement's annual report, the number of students from China and India made Asia the most popular continent of origin.

"Comparable to the drop from calendar year 2020 to 2021, China sent fewer students in 2022 compared to 2021 (-24,796), while India sent more students (+64,300)," the report said.

In 2022, California hosted 225,173 international students -- the largest percentage of international students (16.5 percent) of any US state, the report said, adding that all four regions in the country saw an increase in international student records from 2021 to 2022, with respective increases ranging from 8 to 11 percent, the report said.

There were 276,723 active exchange visitors in the country in 2022, compared to 240,479 active exchange visitors in 2021 -- a 15 percent increase.


The total number of Student and Exchange Visitor Information System records for active F-1 and M-1 students was 1,362,157 in the calendar year 2022 -- an increase of 10.1 percent from the calendar year 2021 and the largest number of records since the calendar year 2019.

SEVIS is a web-based system that the Department of Homeland Security uses to maintain and manage information on non-immigrant students whose primary purpose for coming to the US is to study.

The number of international students enrolled at kindergarten through grade 12 (K12) schools increased by 7.8 percent from 2021 to 2022 (+3,887).

No K-12 schools hosted more than 700 international students in the calendar year 2022, like the calendar year 2021.

The report further said that there were 117,301 pre- and post-completion optional practical training students with both an employment authorization document and who reported working for an employer in the calendar year 2022, compared to 115,651 in the calendar year 2021, a 1.4 percent increase.

PERFUMIST OF PARIS ALKA JOSHI The PERFUMIST OF PARIS

Alka Joshi is the internationally known bestselling author of the Jaipur Trilogy: The Henna

Artist, The Secret Keeper of Jaipur, and her latest, The Perfumist of Paris. Her debut novel, The Henna Artist, immediately became a New York Times Bestseller, a Reese Witherspoon Pick, and was LongListed for the Center for Fiction First Novel Prize. It has been translated into 29 languages and is currently in development at Netflix as a tv series. Joshi was born in India and came to the U.S. with her family at the age of nine. She has a BA from Stanford University and an MFA from California College of Arts. Here in her own words:

When I first started researching perfume

Perfumes! India Has A Huge PR Problem

for my third novel, The Perfumist of Paris, I had no idea that all roads would lead back to India. Neither did my protagonist, Radha. And that made me wonder: Does India have a PR problem?

My adventure started in New York City, the perfume capital of America, where I met with Ann Gottlieb, the powerful woman behind Dior's J'Adore and CK Eternity

among others. Ann invited me to lunch with master perfumer Carlos Benaim and arranged a tour of the formidable International Flavors and Fragrances (IFF) lab.

At IFF, I also met master perfumer Loc Dong, who has collaborated with Ann to create fragrances like Euphoria and Marc Jacobs. Originally from Vietnam, Luc told me his preference for in-

gredients originated from the scents found in his native country. Mango. Jasmine. Ginger. Those were the same fragrances I had always loved — scents from my native India. Until that moment, I had never stopped to wonder about the origin of the myriad ingredients blended to create perfume.

I dug out a photo taken when I was five years old: I'm sitting with my mother in the garden of our house in Rajasthan. She is elegant in her cerulean sari, red lipstick, and a garland of jasmine flowers threaded through the braided bun in her hair. The jasmine vine grew along the back fence of our house.

And the scent of sandalwood! This soothing essential oil is the base note of many of the world's most popular fragrances. In Southern India, the slow-growing tree is now protected because of its popularity with perfumers. Its scent is as familiar to me as my mother's jasmine-scented hair.

I flew to Paris, eager to talk to more perfumers about the inspiration for their favorite ingredients. One of the creators at Firmenich, another fragrance powerhouse, had been raised in Morocco. She referenced the scents of her youth – cloves, bergamot, cinnamon – to design her fragrances.

My next stop was Grasse, followed by Lisbon. In each city, I learned more about the many fragrance ingredients that originally came from India, the Middle East and Northern Africa. Ancient texts confirm the use of ingredients like frankincense, myrrh, and vetiver in ceremonies, palaces, and mosques. Not until the fourteenth century did Europeans begin using scents in daily life—primarily to mask body odor created by poor sanitary habits.

The earliest European traders traveled the renowned spice and silk routes of the East. It was in those hot, tropical regions that traders discovered aromatic ingredients like cloves and cinnamon that their European customers would pay dearly for. Case in point: cloves were once so precious that they were traded for gold.

European demand for fragrances grew quickly. Soon enough, plants like tuberose, orange blossom, and lavender were brought from India and the Mediterranean and planted in southeastern France, in the city of Grasse. Arabs and Hindus alike had long adorned themselves with intense scents like vanilla, ylang-ylang, and oud long before Europeans discovered them. Why then was I just learning about the olfactory contribution of the East to the West? Why, instead, was France reputed to be the perfume capital of the world when the title rightly belonged to countries further East and South?

The more fragrance information I uncovered, the clearer it became to me that the world's finest fragrances owed their success to what they originally harvested—and still procure—from countries like India, the nation of my birth. Which begged the question: why has India not done more to counteract its oft-displayed reputation as a poverty-stricken, underdeveloped country by promoting the story of the origin of fragrances?

I didn't start out with that goal, but that's precisely what I ended up doing in The Perfumist of Paris. My protagonist took me there. Working for a tony perfume company in 1974 Paris, 32-year-old Radha travels to India in search of the missing ingredient for her fragrance project. And she finds it in the moist and sugary soil that India's monsoons leave behind. The scent is mitti ittir.

If I can write well-researched novels that promote India's gifts to the world, why isn't the Indian government promoting her delights as well? Delights like intricate henna designs, thousands of herbal remedies that have inspired the West's "golden lattes" and "chai teas" and...enticing scents that perfume our bodies, our homes, and our environments.

I would apply for a PR position at India, Inc., but I'm a little busy writing novels.


