Record Number Of Indian Illegals Entering US

NEW YORK, NY - A substantial influx of Indian immigrants into the US via its southern border has garnered attention, with The Wall Street Journal reporting that approximately 42,000 individuals were intercepted in the past year alone, according to recent federal statistics.

US Customs and Border Protection disclosed this figure last month, revealing that it is more than double the number from the same period in the previous year when Indian crossings had already reached a record high. The total number of migrant

encounters for the fiscal year has historic first in this regard. surged to 2.48 million, up from 2.38 million in 2022, marking a

US Customs and Border Protection data further reveals that

between February 2019 and March 2023, a staggering 1.49 lakh (149,000) Indians were detained

while attempting illegal entry into the US. Moreover, during this escalating problem, over 1,600 more

people crossed the northern border, a fourfold increase compared to the previous three years combined.

Many of these Indian immigrants enter the country for economic reasons, although they are not eligible for asylum. A significant motivating factor for these migrants is the influence of other Indians who have successfully found employment in the US through similar means.

These individuals often find themselves lured by traffickers employing a method known as "donkey flights," a term derived from a Punjabi saying meaning "to hop from one area to another." This tactic



Jain NGO Raises \$2.1 Million | 2 Get National Science Medal



As Israel's war on Hamas rages, demonstrations are being seen in several countries in support of the Palestinian cause. In India, too, pro-Palestine and anti-Israel protests were held in a few cities.

Some organizations, including Jamiat Ulema-e-Hind and the Left parties, held protests in Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, Kerala, and others against Israeli bombings in Gaza.

But one place that has remained largely silent is Kashmir.

Even though Kashmir is a Muslim-majority valley, the people have decided not to take to the streets on the issue.

SEPARATISTS AND LEADERS
Some separatist leaders and

their sons tried to mobilize supporters soon after Israel declared action in Gaza. On October 13 in central Kashmir's Budgam district Hurriyat leader Aga Syed Hassan's son Muntazir led an anti-Israel and anti-US demonstration following the congregational Friday

prayers. As the separatists tried to fan passions, quick J&K Police response thwarted any conflagration.

Kashmir political leaders also reacted angrily over the bombings

in Gaza. While Prime Minister Narendra Modi was among the first leaders to condemn the Hamas terror attack on Israelis, and after strike on a hospital in Gaza held a phone conversation with Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas to convey condolences over the loss of civilian lives, and reiterated India's "long-standing principled position on the Israel-Palestine issue", the leaders in Kashmir have been trying to whip up passions.

Former Chief Minister and PDP chief Mehbooba Mufti criticized the Government of India's stance on the Hamas attack on Israel. In her October 10 post on X she said, "...Vajpayeeji too called Israel an occupying force which mustn't be allowed to continue reaping the benefits of occupation. Today

once again BJP is choosing their agenda over national policy." She has been tweeting almost every day to stir passions on the crisis.

Former Chief Minister and NC president Farooq Abdullah expressed concern over India's stand. "India since (former Prime

Minister) Jawaharlal Nehru's time supported Palestine and stood against oppression of Palestinians. It's unfortunate the same voices do not come forward to Palestine's support in India anymore. History stands witness that Jews took over the land of Palestinians in Palestine and expanded their territory," Abdullah said.

Hurriyat chairman Mirwaiz Umar Farooq expressed great anguish and grief at the loss of lives and lamented that the international community and the United Nation have failed the people of Palestine. "The issue of Palestine is a long-pending one, and a just solution should be found to it. The rights of the people of Palestine should be given back to them. Their nation and their land have been squeezed. Can there be a bigger oppression than that?"

ANTI INDIA SENTIMENT

While the leaders expressed their feelings and are trying hard to guide sentiments in the valley, the people are not reacting like earlier times when even small happenings were deliberately turned into major anti-India protests and stone pelting sessions.

On December 8, 2017, Kashmir witnessed massive protests over the US recognizing Jerusalem as the capital of Israel. Hundreds of demonstrators held rallies and burned American and Israeli flags and at some places protests took a violent turn as the protesters clashed with security forces.

Six years later the valley is no longer violently reacting to the situation. Leaders trying to whip up passions are not being listened to, and helping maintain peace are the security agencies.

Since 1988 Kashmir has witnessed a lot of bloodshed because

of Pakistan sponsored terrorism. Though there are no official estimates, in the over three-decade period thousands have died, minorities uprooted, and social fabric harmed. Businesses and education suffered. Families were torn apart and people lived in a round-the-clock atmosphere of fear.

Leaders propped up by Pakistan propagated a false narrative of 'azadi' and hundreds of youths were misled to take up guns and many were made stone pelters. The myth was broken soon after the abrogation of Article 370 on August 5, 2019, and now four years later the people have realized the falsehood spread by Pakistan and their prop up in Kashmir.

Investigations by various agencies have helped unmask these leaders, who filled their coffers, built properties in and outside the valley, educated and settled their kin out of Kashmir and country even as they led youths to violence.

TOURISM

Since the abrogation of Article 370, the valley has witnessed a tremendous transformation from terrorism to tourism.

Till September 1.70 crore tourists have already visited UT. This figure may go up to 2.25 crore by the end of the year, a significant increase from last year's 1.88 lakh tourist arrivals, which was the highest number of tourists in the UT in the last seven decades.

The number of foreign tourists to the UT has also seen a major hike from 4,028 foreign arrivals in 2022 to 30,647 in August. Srinagar hosted the G20 meeting (the third

tourism working group meeting of the G20 member countries) and post that, the number of foreign tourist arrivals in J&K has gone up by 350 percent from the last year, Lt. Governor Manoj Sinha has said.

As tourism is booming in the UT, the locals are witnessing the benefits and many unemployed are now earning. Other businesses, like handicrafts, are also showing an upwards trend.

EDUCATION

With the peace pervading, education has also taken precedence. The number of youths qualifying for UPSC is growing every year. And more youths are participating in sports activities. Investments are also picking up and a lot of development projects are upcoming.

The locals, who have borne the brunt of the terror phase, are now realizing the futility of the violence in the name of religion and 'azadi' and are realizing the path of peace and development.

Kashmir was a laboratory for Pakistan and its people were not dear to it. This is what the common Kashmiri has realized. The pathetic situation in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK) has laid bare this truth. The people in PoK are up against Pakistan and its army and seek a merger with India. The truth of the 1988-2019 period of Kashmir is too bitter and tragic that Kashmiris don't want to fall into the trap again. When demonstrations are flooding the streets of the US, Europe, and other countries, Kashmiris prefer to stay silent. They know what the pain of loss is, and they have lost enough. (IANS)



Massive 300,000 Attendance At Yuba City Parade

YUBA CITY, CA – An estimated 300,000 people came to celebrate the Sikh Nagar Kirtan here on November 5, according to KCRA News.

As is the case every year, Sikhs flew in from around North America and elsewhere to take part in a parade that featured floats, music, a show of traditional Sikh martial arts like gatka, great food and religious togetherness.

The entire area was swathed in vibrant colors as the air echoed with kirtans and Punjabi tunes.

As always, the Sikh event featured food stalls that covered the gamut and was served with generosity to all who attended.

The annual Sikh Parade festival was introduced in Yuba City in the 1980s by well-known Punjabi-American peach farmer Didar Singh Bains, also known as the "Peach King".



Both institutions also emphasized their commitment to flexibility, with the ability to modify the agreement upon mutual agreement between academic and administrative representatives.


Bhupesh Parikh Does The Coin Toss For CA's GCC

and former director of the National Science Foundation, Suresh of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology was honored for pioneering research across engineering, physical sciences, and life sciences.

Describing Suresh as a "transformative educator", a White House statement said that his "commitment to research and collaboration across borders has demonstrated how science can forge understanding and cooperation among people and nations". "It's very satisfying," Suresh said in a statement released by Brown University's School of Engineering.

"This is not why you do science. You don't do this for the reward, you do it for joy. If somebody notices it, it's icing on the cake, but it's not the cake itself. This one, though, has added significance because it's from the president of the US. It's national. It has the US stamped on it," Suresh added.

Born in India in 1956, Suresh graduated from high school at 15 and by age 25 had earned his undergraduate degree, master's degree, and Ph.D., which he earned in mechanical engineering from

the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in just two years.

The National Medal of Technology and Innovation was awarded to Ashok Gadgil of the University of California Berkeley and Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory for providing life-sustaining resources to communities around the world. Widely considered to be a "humanitarian inventor", Gadgil was among 12 laureates to receive the honor.

"His innovative, inexpensive technologies help meet profound needs, from drinking water to fuelefficient cookstoves. His work is inspired by a belief in the dignity of all people and in our power to solve the great challenges of our time," the White House statement read.

Established by Congress in 1959, the National Medal of Science is conferred directly by the president and is the highest recognition the nation can bestow on scientists and engineers. The National Medal of Technology and Innovation is given for outstanding contributions to the promotion of technology for the improvement of the economic, environmental, and social well-being of the US.

valuable catch-and-shoot threat, streakingthelawn.com said.



CA Politician Denied Indian Citizenship

HYDERABAD, (IANS) – In a setback for Jhansi Reddy, a member of the Congress party, her application for Indian citizenship has been denied by Indian authorities. Jhansi Reddy, who holds American citizenship, had aspired to contest on the Congress ticket for the Palakurthi Assembly constituency.

The Hyderabad District Collector conveyed to Reddy that her request for Indian citizenship could not be entertained because she had not maintained continuous residence in India for a full year immediately preceding her application date. She had applied for Indian citizenship.

The District Collector's communication indicated that although she entered India on June 16, 2022, she had not fulfilled the essential requirement of residing in India for a consecutive 12-month period before the application date, which is a mandatory condition for citizenship eligibility.

Jhansi Reddy is known for her role as the founder and president of the Women Empowerment Telugu Association, an organization based in the United States to create opportunities for women. She has also been involved in philanthropic work in the Palakurthi constituency, which is currently represented by BRS leader and Minister for Panchayat Raj, E. Dayakar Rao.

In anticipation of receiving a Congress ticket, Jhansi had been actively campaigning in the Palakurthi constitu-



ency for the past several weeks.

In 1982, she married cardiologist Dr. Hanumandla Rajender Reddy of California. She has played an active role in various Telugu associations. She served as a member of the board of directors for the American Telugu Association from 2007 to 2009 and the North American Telugu Association from 2010 to 2014. Additionally, she served as the president of the Telangana American Telugu Association from 2015 to 2018. The couple cofounded the Hanumandla Rajender and Jhansi Reddy Foundation, a non-profit organization engaged in philanthropic activities in the US and India.

In 2006, they donated \$1 million to establish a student health center at the University of California, Merced. They have also contributed \$1 million to various service projects in rural villages in the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

CUPERTINO, CA – Apple has achieved an all-time revenue record in India in the September quarter, said CEO Tim Cook, adding that there is a lot of headroom to grow in the country where "a lot of people are moving into the middle class."

During the company's quarterly earnings call late on November 2, where Apple said it posted quarterly revenue of \$89.5 billion, the iPhone maker grew in very strong double digits in India in the July-September quarter (which also new iPhone 15 series sales which started on September 22).

"We achieved an all-time revenue record in India as well as September quarter records in several countries, including Brazil, Canada, France, Indonesia, Mexico, the Philippines, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, the UAE, Vietnam and more," said Cook.

"In services, we set an all-time revenue record with double-digit growth and ahead of our expectations," he added.

In response to an analyst question on momentum in India, Cook said that India is "an incredibly exciting market for them and a major focus" for the company.

"We have a low share in a large market and so there's a lot of headroom there. We see an extraordinary market - a lot of people moving into the middle class," the Apple CEO noted.

"Lots of positives, we put two retail stores there and they are doing better than we anticipated — it's still early going but they are off to a good start, and I couldn't be happier with how things are going at the moment," he added.

Apple's revenue in India hit nearly Rs 50,000 crore in FY23, with sales increasing 48 percent to Rs 49,321 crore and net profit rising 76 percent to Rs 2,229 crore.

The company recorded its highest-ever quarterly shipments in India, crossing 2.5 million units, in the third quarter (July-September period) this year.

Luca Maestri, Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, at Apple, said that the company reached a September quarter record on iPhone, driven by strength in emerging markets.

"Our total installed base of active devices reached an all-time high across all products and all geographic segments. Thanks to our high levels of customer satisfaction and many new customers joining our ecosystem," said Maestri.

"We are expanding our direct presence with new Apple Retail Stores in India to online stores in Vietnam and Chile," he added.



Palestinians Have Right To Peace, Dignity: Congressman Ami Bera

ELK GROVE, CA (IANS) – Congressman Ami Bera has called for immediate cessation of military operations in Gaza to get needed humanitarian aid, food, water, and medicine to struggling civilians.

Gaza city and northern Gaza have been "largely cut off" from the rest of the Hamas-controlled enclave because of the Israeli ground operations, hampering the delivery of humanitarian aid to some 300,000 internally displaced people in the north, according to the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs.

Bera in a video message said that while he "firmly believes" that Israel has the right to exist and defend itself, so do "innocent Palestinians who have a right to a life of peace and dignity".

"We need an immediate pause in order to get needed humanitarian aid, food, water and medicine to struggling civilians; then we need to find a different path forward," Bera said, after speaking to the Palestinians and Jews in his constituency.



The Congressman said he hoped to see Israelis and Palestinians living side by side in peace, which can only happen if innocent Israelis and Palestinians are not killed.

In addition, Bera, along with Congressman Andy Kim, is leading 89 colleagues in demanding the US Congress to immediately pass the President's request for Fiscal Year 2024 emergency supplemental funding.

Call To "Eliminate" Hamas



Thanedar Makes

WASHINGTON, DC – Congressman Shri Thanedar, has removed himself from the membership of the Democratic Socialists of America after the group promoted a pro-Palestinian rally a day after Hamas' deadly terrorist attack on Israel.

Thanedar cited what he called a "hate-filled and antisemitic rally in New York City," which other progressives in Congress have also condemned. "After the brutal terrorist attacks on Israel, which included the indiscriminate murder, rape, and kidnapping of innocent men, women, and children, I can no longer associate with an organization unwilling to call out terrorism in all its forms," Thanedar said in his statement.

"Sunday's hate-filled and antisemitic rally in New York City, promoted by the NYC-DSA, makes it impossible for me to continue my affiliation," he added. "I stand with Israel and its right to defend itself. There is no place for moral equivocation in the face of unadulterated evil as we have seen from Hamas."

On October 23, speaking at an event in support of Israel at the US Capitol Hill on October 23, he was equally unequivocal about his stance.

"Hamas is not a militant organization. Hamas is not a resistance movement; they are just barbaric terrorists. This is a time when we just can't just push them because they will regroup and come back and do these atrocities once again. Yes, that's what they will do. So, you know, we need at this stage to eliminate them. Eliminate the space of this, you know, we need to dismantle their military operations," Thanedar said.

Thanedar said, "We need to free the Palestinian people, the two million Palestinian people that live in Gaza. They need to be freed from these terrorist controls of Gaza. So that addition is what I feel. Now there is a lot of talk about ceasefire, but I feel that it's premature, these Hamas terrorists have used the civilians."

HinduACTion and Namaste Shalom Multi-faith Alliance organized the Congressional briefing in support of Israel and against rising anti-Hindu bigotry and antisemitism in the US and Canada.

Meanwhile, Nissim Reuben, Program Director of Indian-Jewish Relations at the American Jewish Committee, said at a Congressional briefing in support of Israel that India is the only country with no history of antisemitism.

He also expressed solidarity with Israel in its fight against the terrorist group Hamas.

He further expressed gratitude that the Indian American diaspora, the global Indian diaspora, the people of India, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and the Indian government have solidly supported Israel in its ongoing war with Hamas.





Indian Illegals Entering US

Various social media platforms have featured videos showing men and women taking different routes to reach the United States, one of the most perilous being the Darien jungle—a hazardous 66-mile passage between Panama and Colombia that leads to Central America and the United States. Known for its venomous wildlife, treacherous terrain, and challenging navigation, it is considered one of the riskiest migration routes globally.

In the past, Indian illegals favored entering the US through the

border with Mexico rather than the border with Canada. However, the number of arrests on the US-Mexico border closely aligned with those at the US-Canada border in September, totaling 3,862. Many of these illegal immigrants, most of whom are reported to be from Gujarat, have either settled in Canada or are awaiting a chance to enter the United States.

According to The Wall Street Journal, Mexico tops the list globally in terms of infiltrators, with 21 lakh (2.1 million) individuals, followed by Honduras (6.42 lakh), Guatemala (6.37 lakh), Cuba (4.06 lakh), and Venezuela (3.23 lakh).

US Proposes Changes In H-1B Process To Reduce Fraud

WASHINGTON DC (ANI) – The Joe Biden administration in the United States has proposed changes in the H-1B visa program to streamline eligibility requirements and make it more efficient and flexible.

The changes have been proposed by the US Department of Homeland Security, which stated that the changes will also lead to a reduction in cases of misuse and fraud.

"The US Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS), published a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) that would modernize the H-1B specialty occupation worker program by streamlining eligibility requirements, improving program efficiency, providing greater benefits and flexibilities for employers and workers, and strengthening integrity measures," the department said in a statement.

The US Secretary of Homeland Security, Alejandro N Mayorkas said that the priority of the Biden administration is to attract global talent and reduce undue burdens on employers.

"DHS continues to develop and implement regulations that increase efficiency and improve

processes for employers and workers navigating the immigration system," the Secretary of Homeland Security, Alejandro N Mayorkas said.

He added, "The Biden-Harris Administration's priority is to attract global talent, reduce undue burdens on employers, and prevent fraud and abuse in the immigration system."

According to the department, the proposed changes would streamline eligibility requirements. Under this, the criteria for specialty occupation positions would be revised to reduce confusion between the public and adjudicators and to clarify that a position may allow a range of degrees, although there must be a direct relationship between the required degree field(s) and the duties of the position.

The proposed rule also codifies that adjudicators generally should defer to a prior determination when no underlying facts have changed at the time of a new filing.

Aiming to pro-

vide more flexibility, the department has proposed certain exemptions to the H-1B cap to be expanded for certain non-profit entities or governmental research organizations as well as beneficiaries who are not directly employed by a qualifying organization.

DHS would also extend certain flexibility for students on an F-1 visa when students are seeking to change their status to H-1B. Additionally, DHS would establish new H-1B eligibility requirements for rising entrepreneurs, the department stated.

According to the US department, misuse, and fraud in the H-1B registration process would also be reduced by prohibiting related entities from submitting multiple registrations for the same beneficiary.

Saudi Eyeing IPL Stake: Bloomberg

NEW DELHI (IANS) - Saudi Arabia has expressed interest in buying a multibillion-dollar stake in the Indian Premier League (IPL), international cricket's most lucrative event, following a string of investments that have upended professional sports, including football and golf, a media report said.

Saudi Arabian Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman's advisors have spoken to Indian government officials about moving the IPL into a holding company valued at as much as \$30 billion,

Bloomberg reported.

The talks were held when the Saudi Crown Prince visited India in September for the G20 Summit held under India's Presidency, the report said.

Saudi Arabia proposed investing as much as \$5 billion into the league and help lead an expansion into other countries, the report said.

As per earlier reports, the IPL ecosystem value has risen from Rs 87,000 crore to Rs 92,500 crore, marking an increase of around 6.3 percent, as per a report by D&P

India Advisory Services.

This translates to a growth from \$10.9 billion to \$11.2 billion, representing an increase of approximately 3.3 percent.

The league has always been a spectacle of cricket, business, and entertainment. This year was no exception, as the league continued to captivate audiences, both on television and digital platforms, the report said.

According to the Broadcast Audience Research Council (BARC) India, the IPL telecast on the Star Sports Network attracted a stag-

gering 505 million viewers with an impressive watch time of 427.1 billion minutes. On the digital front, JioCinema reported that

449 million viewers tuned into its platform, with over 126 million viewers choosing connected TV options to savor the IPL action.

Bishan Singh Bedi: Audacious, Outspoken And Man With A Big Heart

MUMBAI - As the praise and memories of this great cricketer pours in from peers, current players, the Prime Minister, Bollywood and the ordinary citizen, here is a look at Bishan Singh Bedi.

After an embarrassing defeat to Australia in the Rothmans Cup in New Zealand in 1990, the manager of the Indian cricket team had famously declared to the media: "The entire team should be dumped into the Pacific." That was Bishan Singh Bedi, never afraid to speak his mind, never one to mince words, and always ready to call a spade a spade.

It was his aura as one of the

greatest left-arm spinners the game had seen, which gave Bedi the audacity to be upfront and undiplomatic at times. His words never had the loop and spin that Bedi put in his bowling. At the core of his heart, Bishan Singh Bedi was always anti-establishment and fought with the Board of Control for Cricket in India administrators for his teammates and fellow cricketers.

A key member of India's famous spin quartet of the 1970s, left-arm spinner Bishan Singh Bedi passed away on October 23, aged 77. Bedi played 67 Tests for India between 1967 and 1979, taking 266 wickets at an average of 28.71, apart from making 656 runs with the bat.

A tough taskmaster, Bedi may not have endeared himself to the various teams that he coached and managed — from the Delhi Ranji Trophy team to the senior national team, but as a spinner par excellence, he always commanded respect, coaching players like Maninder Singh and Murali Karthik among others.

It was his aura and abilities as a brilliant spinner and cricketer that on many occasions foreign teams would send their spinners to train under Bedi before unleashing them on the Indian team. Bedi was never economical or frugal in dispensing with his wisdom, whoever sought it, whether an Indian or otherwise.

But his teammates and rivals would also remember Bedi for his big heart as a cricketer, who was always ready to praise a batsman for attacking him and a spinner for his bowling skills. He was a man with a heart of gold.

Considered to be one of the greatest left-arm spinners to have played the game, Bedi was part of the famous Indian spin quartet alongside Erapalli Prasanna, B.S. Chandrashekar, and S. Venkataraghavan that won India many matches in both home and overseas conditions in the 1970s.

He also took seven wickets in 10 ODI matches, apart from captaining India in 22 Tests - with its most memorable wins coming in Melbourne and Sydney Tests in the 1977-78 tour of Australia.

Born in Amritsar, Punjab, Bedi

began his first-class career with Northern Punjab, before moving to Delhi in the 1968-69 season, shortly after making his India Test debut in 1966. His left-arm spin bowling was known for the mastery he had of flight, loop, and spin, along with using subtle variations to outwit batters at the crease, with tiny adjustments made in his superior arm speed release points.

Bedi also led Delhi to winning the prestigious Ranji Trophy titles in 1978-79 and 1979-80, apart from two runners-up finishes. He also had a successful stint for Northamptonshire at county cricket in England. In 102 outings for the club between 1972 and 1977, Bedi bagged 434 wickets, the most by an Indian in the English County cricket circuit, while averaging 20.89.

Post his playing career, Bedi turned to coaching young cricketers, with Maninder Singh and Murali Kartik being his students to have played for India. He also coached Punjab, Delhi, and Jammu & Kashmir teams in domestic cricket, with Punjab winning the Ranji Trophy in 1992-93.

He was conferred with the Arjuna Award in 1969, the Padma Shri in 1970 and the C. K. Nayudu Lifetime Achievement Award in 2004.

Recently, Bedi had been unwell and had to undergo multiple surgeries, including one on the knee which happened in late September this year. He is survived by his wife Anju, and two children: Neha and Angad, a film actor.

Though he never said it aloud, one of Bedi's regrets in his life was not seeing his son Angad Singh Bedi following in his footsteps as a great spinner.

One still distinctly remembers being sent to his office as a cub reporter for a story on a team of school kids that Bedi had taken on a tour of England in the late 1990s. Bedi gave all figures and spells bowled by Angad not as a doting father but as a spinner and coach, marveling at the loop he created and the spin he imparted to his deliveries.

Bedi worked hard on his bowling and Angad did show a lot of promise early but then he found his interests elsewhere.



AHMEDABAD – The rising problem of stray cattle and dogs on urban streets has led to another tragic incident, as businessman Parag Desai, Wagh Bakri Group's Executive Director, lost his life on October 22 due to an accident involving street dogs.

He oversaw the sales, marketing, and export departments of the Rs 1,500 crore group that was founded by his greatgrandfather. He expanded the brand into tea lounges and introduced new products like iced tea.

He was also active on industry platforms like the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) and international organizations.

Beyond business, Desai had a charitable side, supporting organizations such as the Blind People's Association and Jivdaya Charitable Trust, a prominent animal hospital in Ahmedabad.



MUMBAI - Atul V. Bedekar, the spice and pickles king, and Director of the V. P. Bedekar & Sons group, passed away following a prolonged illness early on November 3, family sources said here. He was 56 and breathed his last around 12.30 a.m. at a private hospital after a long fight with cancer. Bedekar's last rites were performed at a crematorium in south Mumbai. 



The promo 'the show host Karan Johar telling Sara: "There were alleged rumors about you dating Shubman Gill."




To which she quipped: "You have got the wrong Sara, guys. Sara ka saara duniya galat Sara ke peecche pada hai."


