Population: India Set to Surpass China in 2023 Says UN

NEW YORK, NY - The global population is projected to reach 8 billion on November 15, with India projected to surpass China as the most populous country in 2023, the UN said on July 11 on World Population Day.

"It is a reminder of our shared responsibility to care for our planet and a moment to reflect on where we still fall short of our commitments to one another," said UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres. The growth rate is at its slowest since 1950, having fallen under 1 percent in 2020, according to the World Population

Prospects 2022.

The world's population could grow to around 8.5 billion in 2030 and 9.7 billion in 2050 and peak at around 10.4 billion during the 2080s. But the population of the world is expanding unevenly.

More than half of the projected increase up to 2050 will be con-

centrated in eight countries: Congo, Egypt, Ethiopia, India, Nigeria, Pakistan, the Philippines, and Tanzania, it added.

With one of the lowest fertility rates in the world (at 1.15 children per woman), China has announced that its population is due to start declining next year - much earlier than previously thought. That is

despite the country abandoning its one child policy in 2016 and introducing incentives for couples to have two or more children, the BBC reported.

As India's population continues to grow it will almost certainly overtake China as the country with the biggest population in the world.

In New Jersey, BAPS Opens Its First Research Center in the US

ROBBINSVILLE, NJ - The BAPS Swaminarayan Research Institute, the first such center of learning and research of Indian languages and Hindu scriptures in the Swaminarayan tradition in the US, was inaugurated here, at the site of Swaminarayan Akshardham on June 18.

The event took place in the presence of over 115 representatives from over 50 Hindu temples and organizations, guests and scholars.




The center was packed with devotees not only from the Southern California region but from throughout the US, India, and even Africa.

History Shows Putin's Claims to Ukraine are **Dubious**

Asserting that Ukraine had no existence as a state and that Ukrainians and Russians are one people, out of hubris, Vladimir Putin ordered an unprovoked and unjustified invasion of a sovereign country, Ukraine in utter disregard of international law. But historians do not agree with Putin's claims to Ukraine. It is true that Kievan Rus, as a loose federation of Russia, Ukraine, and had existed in the medieval ages. However, with the Mongolian empire, it was fragmented into principalities. For the next four hundred years, these territories comprising present Ukraine were ruled by Poland-Lithuania. The Orthodox East Slavic people in these lands developed their own distinct identity and language under Mongol and later Muscovite rule. And from the 16th to 18th centuries, these East Orthodox Slavic hosts of peasant warriors, known as the Cossacks, formed their own de facto statelets.

In 1552, Ivan the Terrible conquered the Mongolian Khanate of Kazan, and later the eastern parts of Ukraine including Kiev, that were under Polish-Lithuanian control were ceded to Moscow in 1667. However, supported by Sweden, the Cossacks fought the Russians in the Great Northern War (1700-1725) during the reign of Peter the Great but lost and Russia emerged as an empire. With three partitions of Poland as a result of regional wars, the remainder of modernday Ukraine was absorbed by Czarist Russia except for its extreme western part which came under Austria.

For the next 120 years, Ukraine was a part of Russia which suppressed its people's identity, culture, and language. In the civil war following the October 1917 Bolshevik revolution, Ukraine enjoyed a quasi-independence but was partitioned between the Soviet Union and newly independent Poland. But by December 1922 the two parts of Ukraine were joined to become one of the Soviet Union's 15 republics under Lenin. In Joseph Stalin's regime (1924-53), as Ukrainians had resisted his forced collectivization, he ruthlessly starved them causing deaths between 3.5 to 5 million. He however, permitted Ukraine to be a separate member of the newly founded United Nations in 1945.

It was Nikita Khrushchev a Ukrainian himself, who in 1954 made Crimea as part of Ukraine. Following the collapse of the Soviet Union in December 1991, President Boris Yeltsin (1990-99) let Ukraine declare itself as an independent nation and recognized it as such. Historically, Ukrainians have sought to be independent contrary to what Putin claims. Putin refuses to recognize Ukraine's existence, and in 2014, he annexed Crimea and has been supporting the Russian rebels in the Donbas region.

Putin desires to restore the former Czarist empire with him being a ruler for life.

Revoke The Second Amendment

Another mass shooting, in the suburb of Highland Park Chicago grips America. The multiple guns used by the shooter were purchased legally, courtesy of the NRA, Republicans, and radical members of the Supreme Court. No one is safe in America, not schools, grocery stores, not even parades celebrating the birth of our nation.

America is alone in the world with its obsession with guns not the sanctity of life.

Politicians continue to enjoy campaign contributions from the NRA even though the organization is riddled with corruption and was forced to file for bankruptcy protection. Their non-profit status should be revoked immediately.

The right to carry weapons of war has been justified by the "Second Amendment," but former Supreme Court Justices, Warren Berger and John Paul Stevens argued vociferously that individual gun rights was a "massive fraud perpetrated on the American people and should be revoked."

A bevy of scholars agrees, arguing a "well-regulated militia" was only necessary to protect the country during the birth of our nation but has now been replaced by multiple agencies, Homeland Security, the FBI, the National Guard, and US Law Enforcement Agencies. Thus, the Second Amendment clause, "the right to bear arms" is completely outdated and should be revoked immediately. It has been used by the NRA as a cash cow to sell guns and weapons of war.

India Cannot be Taken For Granted!

The crisis in Ukraine has underscored the new reality that India has changed in the past decade. The country has refused to succumb to the continued pressure of the United States and Western Europe to engage in economic boycott of Russia. The conflict between Russia and Ukraine, in India's view, is a European problem and not a 'world problem'. The current leaders

of India also do not believe that the United States and western European countries can write the book on world order and expect India to abide by that rule book. India sees the world to be bigger than just Europe and America. Consequently, India is not willing to make serious economic sacrifices simply for the sake of complying with the West.

India is a vibrant democracy. Domestic public opinion is a very important factor in guiding India's foreign policy. No different from that of the United States. Indians are acutely aware of the exploitation by the British rulers just as they are aware of the Moghul invaders destroying the Hindu temples to replace them with mosques. Nothing has happened that can help the Indians to forget this painful history and overcome the mistrust of the foreigners. India's governing party, the Bharatiya Janata Party, is built on the strong foundation of nationalism. The country's immensely popular leader, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has very effectively maintained an independent foreign policy which is now guided by its own national interest. India's Hindu majority is very strongly behind the ruling party's commitment to make Hindu civilization the center of Indian cultural and political life. This nationalist India wants to develop the Indian power and not let its sovereignty be dwarfed by the western powers.

India has now become a serious economic power offering a viable alternative to the giant American business enterprises who are becoming increasingly leery of continuing to depend on China. The United States government is concerned about the serious national security risks in having these businesses operating in China.

India's strategic location also makes it extremely vital for the United States to cultivate a strong military collaboration with India to contain China's aggressive moves in the Indo-Pacific region. The role India can play in limiting China's economic and military dominance is very significant.

United States and the other western countries need to recognize the new reality and treat India with much care and respect. The old habits will not work. Many Indians bristle when they feel they are being lectured by the American media while the US is suffering from racial injustice and mass shootings. They consider such lectures as the good old 'western arrogance'. Majority of Indians want to see that India proudly maintains its independent identity. That is the mandate Indians have given to the ruling party. It is that pure and simple.





Yantra: A Kitchen That Balances Flavors Perfectly

ARTESIA, CA - In the new avatar of Yantra Kitchen in Artesia, CA, the diner gets not a fancy menu with French and Spanishinspired names but instead, a smart menu. One that is keenly aware of the makeup of the pedestrian traffic in 'Little India' and yet strives to be a step up for those not wanting to simply down a quick chaat washed down by a lassi in a paper cup.

Yantra's papdi chaat, in fact, is a balanced explosion of sweet, sour, salt, and heat in every mouthful. Even the yogurt has been worked on, with an almost airy feeling. And this is the restaurant's calling card mostly familiar food but brilliantly cooked. Who knew jeera rice did not have to come burdened with ghee but that every forkful could look plump and feel feather light on the tongue?

Then there is the smartly named Portuguese fish fry; Artesia after all has that nation's antecedents. It really is an Amritsari fish (itself a wonder given that city is landlocked) that again, diners will affirm shows balance in flavors with the tamarind sauce giving the flaky Vietnamese catfish filets a pep. For vegetarians, the fried cauliflower with a sweet undertone and served with bits of colorful peppers is a dish to be savored.

The deliciousness of the appetizers, it is soon learned, is the skilled work of chef Sanjay Jaitly. He steps out of the kitchen to talk to customers and unlike most other Indian restaurant chefs, is crisply dressed in whites without the telltale streaks of turmeric and oil stains.

A short chit-chat later it becomes apparent why - growing up in Austria, he attended an elite hospitality school in Salzburg. He easily drops names of Thomas Keller, Wolfgang Puck, and the like, and speaks of riboflavins and folic acid and the ingredients

from which they can be derived and added to restaurant dishes

able drinks to sip on while eating. But skipping all the drinks in the dine-in menu and looking to the bar, which is a full-service



to make it a healthier experience. He has

brought all this understanding and professional training to bear at jobs in Novotel, Rosenberger Hotels, Cunard, and the Sunset Tower in Los Angeles, among others, and now, Yantra.

From the kitchen he sends out a Goa coconut curry that like a Thai curry can be ordered with the additions of veggies, chicken, or shrimp. The restaurant also offers a roasted Bengal-inspired fish and an interesting lamb chop that has a mango marinade and a basil oil drizzle. Vegetarians have a slew of paneer and dal dishes to pick from as well as the kadhi pakora, not always on Indian restaurant menus.

The regular breads to accompany these dishes are there as well as a malai naan and a truffle one. Then there is the kulcha. Made by Jaitly, it is easy to devour.

Yantra offers a bunch of familiar and comfort-

one, is a promising experience. In the event, that alcohol is not a choice on a working day, the mixologist is more than happy to create mocktails that satisfy.

Reshma Makkar, daughter of the new owner Munish Makkar, helps out when he is not there and she points out other stuff not on the menu - the food carts parked on the outside of the restaurant hugging an alley to the parking lot. One serves paan and the other gol gappas, including a vodkainfused one. The lines, she says, are long on the weekend with people reveling in the streetside encounter so evocative of India.

So, dine-in or street food - Yantra might have something for all.





India Tech Sector Helped US Generate \$103 Bln in 2021



and is therefore well equipped to understand and meet the critical skill challenges of the digital age," said Debjani Ghosh, President. Nasscom.

NEW DELHI, (IANS) - The Indian tech industry generated \$103 billion in revenue and directly employed 2,07,000 people in the US last year, with an average wage of \$106,360 -- witnessing a 22 percent employment growth since 2017, a new Nasscom report showed on July 13.

The direct impact of the Indian tech industry has helped the US economy generate a total of \$396 billion in sales to date, supporting 1.6 million jobs and contributing over \$198 billion to the American economy -- larger than the combined economies of 20 US states in 2021, according to report by Nassom and IHS Markit (now part of S&P global).

"The Indian tech sector works with more than 75 percent of the fortune 500 companies, most of them headquartered in the US,

The Indian technology companies have contributed over \$1.1 billion and developed partnerships with nearly 180 universities, colleges, community colleges, and others to strengthen and diversify the STEM pipeline in the US.

It also has provided over \$3 million more for just K-12 initiatives. These efforts have touched over 2.9 million students and teachers to date in the US.

In addition, over 2,55,000 current employees have been upskilled by the sector, the report noted.

The Indian technology industry in the US has played a role in expanding the talent pool outside of traditional tech hub states. This has contributed to some of these states, such as North Carolina, becoming emergent hubs.



NEW DELHI, (IANS) - Twitter has moved the Karnataka High Court against the Indian government's order to take down some content on its platform, on the grounds that the content blocking orders from the IT Ministry does not pass "the test of the grounds provided under Section 69A of the IT Act", reliable sources said.

Twitter has alleged in its writ petition that multiple accounts and content included in the blocking orders are either "overbroad and arbitrary", fail to provide notice to the "originators" of the content, and are "disproportionate" in several cases. The social media platform alleged in the court petition that several blocking orders that were issued to Twitter only "cite" the grounds of Section 69A but fail to demonstrate how the content falls within those grounds or how the said content is "violative" of Section 69A, the sources added.

In a June letter, the IT Ministry had warned Twitter of strict action if it does not comply with some content takedown orders.

According to sources, Twitter

has now sought judicial review of some of the content that forms a part of various blocking orders.

According to the writ petition, account-level blocking is a "principally disproportionate measure" and "violates rights of users under the constitution, especially when the reasons stated to block URLs and reasons stated to block an account lack specificity and merely cite grounds under Section 69A".

Earlier this month, Delhi Police sent a notice to Twitter seeking details of the account that led to the arrest of fact-checking website Alt News' co-founder Mohammed Zubair. Twitter was also involved in a legal battle in the Delhi High Court last year with the Centre over not complying with the new IT Rules of 2021.

SEATTLE, WA - A man has been arrested for threatening to kill Indian American Congresswoman Pramila Jayapal at her home here, The Hill reported.

According to a police report, Brett Forsell was on the night of July 9, when they found him standing in on the street by Jayapal's house, hands in the air, with a handgun on his waist.

Neighbors said he threatened to kill her and according to police probable cause documents was yelling something to the effect of "go back to India, I'm going to

A statement from Jayapal's office confirmed the incident had happened and that she and her family were safe. She also thanked Seattle and Capitol police as well as the FBI for their swift reaction.

Because this is an ongoing incident, the Congresswoman said she would not have any more to say on the matter.

A spokesperson for Jayapal released a statement, confirming she was at home during the incident. "The Congresswoman and her family are safe and appreciate the many calls and good wishes she is receiving from constituents. She is very grateful for the swift and professional response from the Seattle Police Department, the U.S. Capitol Police, and the FBI investigators who are working together diligently on the investigation and ensuring that she and her family stay safe."

The King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office said in a statement that a judge set bail for the 48-year-old suspect at \$500,000, as is normal for armed threats to kill and hate crimes.

Ramesh Balwani of Theranos Faces 20 Years

SAN FRANCISCO, CA - Indian American Ramesh 'Sunny' Balwani, the former business partner and 'boyfriend in secret' of Elizabeth Holmes, founder, and CEO of healthcare company Theranos, has been found guilty of defrauding investors and patients.

Balwani faced 10 counts of wire fraud and two counts of conspiracy to commit wire fraud. After a three-month trial, a 12 member jury found him guilty of all 12 counts.

Balwani sat impassively as the verdicts were read. After the verdicts were read, Balwani walked over to his two brothers who sat behind him. They sat quietly, heads bowed.

Holmes has already been found guilty of defrauding investors. Both Holmes, 38, and Balwani, 57, face up to 20 years in prison. Holmes is scheduled to be sentenced in late September. The date of Balwani's sentencing is expected to be set in the coming days.

Balwani was Holmes' "boyfriend in secret". "They met when Holmes was 18 and Balwani was 37 -- she moved in with him the



year after she dropped out of Stanford. She also said during the trial that she was raped as a Stanford student, which is part of why she didn't finish her degree."

During the four months of court proceedings, Holmes detailed Balwani's controlling behavior, including a written document that dictated her daily schedule, including what she ate, when she slept and how she dressed. She said, "He was so disappointed in my mediocrity, and he was trying to teach me how to be better."

Holmes founded Theranos in 2003 and the company was once valued at more than \$9 billion.

In 2015, an expose in The Wall Street Journal revealed major problems with Theranos'

technology. In 2018, Holmes and Balwani were charged with two counts of conspiracy to commit wire fraud and nine counts of wire fraud.

According to the Department of Justice, Holmes and Balwani used advertisements and solicitations to encourage and induce doctors and patients to use Ther-

anos's blood testing laboratory services, even though, according to the government, the defendants knew Theranos was not capable of consistently producing accurate and reliable results for certain blood tests.

"It is further alleged that the tests performed on Theranos technology were likely to contain inaccurate and unreliable results," the Justice Department said.

Holmes and Balwani defrauded doctors and patients by making false claims concerning Theranos's ability to provide accurate, fast, reliable, and cheap blood tests and test results, and by omitting information concerning the limits of and problems with Theranos' technologies.

Annette Philip: Indian Music is at the Intersection of Freedom & Rules

If you are a budding musician, the Berklee School of Music in Boston is something you aspire to. If you are Indian American and have finer music tastes, the Berklee Indian Ensemble is something that fascinates and delights. A decade old now and with millions of YouTube hits, its unique choral arrangements, and exemplary collaborations with exceptional artists, have all been spearheaded by Annette Philip. For the viewer, she is the one with the wide smile, sparkling eyes, and colorful sarees effortlessly conveying a sense of joy.

Philip is a Keralite, with years spent in Singapore and Delhi

which is where she first founded an artist collective. The ups and downs, mistakes, and epiphanies from each of these experiences brought her to the college where she not only founded the Ensemble but is also a faculty member. Fresh off the release of the Ensemble's debut album she told India-West:

Q: You have worked with AR Rahman and Shankar Mahadevan. How different were their styles and what did you learn from them?

A: Rahman Sir had always been a musical hero of mine and is one of the most introspective people I've met in my life. He's a wonderful mentor and a true genius as a musician, composer, arranger, and musical director. He is obsessed with sound while being

very playful, and I learned to be even more exacting as a producer through my interactions with him at Berklee and my subsequent tours with him.

Shankar Mahadevan is such a virtuosic improviser, and master vocalist and composer. He is such an extrovert, ever willing to

experiment and also be playful in music-making! He is wonderful at working a crowd, and each time we get to create with him, he surprises us with really unique variations - It's a marvel to witness how his brain works, and his artistry astounds us constantly.

Q: What has been the response to your debut album?

A: The response to 'Shuru-aat' has been heartwarming and overwhelmingly positive! First off, after a decade, our loyal fans are ecstatic to finally stream our music on Spotify, JioSaavn, Apple Music, and other platforms worldwide! Secondly, fans and serious musicians from the arts industry are amazed that the album features 98 musicians from 39 countries, with 10 tracks that represent such a diverse mosaic of genres, languages, global cultural nuances, and energy!

Q: Why did you have Shreya Ghoshal reinterpret the track 'Sundari Pennae?'

A: Berklee Indian Ensemble artist residencies always focus on exploring both the classic hits as well as relatively unknown works of our guests. Shreya Ghoshal's discography is so vast, and when we came across Sundari Pennae and fell in love with two aspects immediately. One, we love oddtime signatures, and this was a song in 5! And the harmonium hook inspired us to experiment a ton with it. It's such a sweet song, but we wondered what would happen if we completely deconstructed it, and added a progressive rock feel. Shreyaji loved our reinterpretation, and we're so thrilled to have collaborated with her on this!

Q: Does it ever scare you to play around with iconic tunes? Have you ever got blowback for it?

A: It doesn't scare us because we know we always approach re-arrangements with sincerity and respect. We honor the original intention of the composer by studying their music, analyzing the lyrics, and really delving deep into their artistic choices. From there, we begin experimenting,

and as long as we stay authentic to ourselves, creative liberty is an artist's right. We've never gotten negative feedback about our reinterpretations because I believe the audience understands that we're paying homage to the original while staying true to ourselves.

Q: It's almost magical when tunes and movements pop out of composing minds. Can you explain how the creative process works for you?

A: I draw inspiration from my environment (food, nature, colors, textures, paintings, film) as well as my emotions (memories from childhood, sensory memories of smell or taste, or even the feeling of relief from hugging a loved one). The technical aspects come from study but most importantly, taste, developed by listening to tons and tons of music from around the world. My process depends on the day, the goal of the project, or my mood. Sometimes while improvising freely, an idea will emerge that you fall in love with, and then it's simply being resistance-free, allowing the song to tell you where it wants to go. Other times, you feel stuck, and you test different ideas till the jigsaw pieces come together and hope you like it the next day. As creators, we don't always adore what we make, but the point is to keep showing up to create.

Q: Is there anything about Indian music that situates it uniquely for exploration?

A: Indian music sits at a delightful intersection of freedom and rules; rhythmic and melodic complexity juxtaposed with harmonic simplicity. That's what has shaped the Berklee Indian Ensemble signature sound. Honoring Indian folk, classical, and Sufi traditions while allowing for chords, harmonies, and non-Indian stylistic elements to be blended.



The India-born Gopinath has served as the first female chief economist of the IMF for the last three years.


She has a PhD in economics from Princeton University with earlier degrees from the University of Delhi, Delhi School of Economics, and the University of Washington.



"You will see that the tombstones here reflect the diversity of America," Khan said, as a reflection of the diversity of those who have served. "Humayun, from a very early age, became fully convinced that service to the nation is the highest honor. When I look at our patriots in uniform, it convinces me that our future is brighter because of their service, and their families' service. We are grateful to each of them," said Khan.

Khan, who is also a South Asians for America Advisory Council member, offered advice considering recent events to the AAPI community gathered. "Our democracy and our democratic values are being challenged...Women's equal dignity is under attack. Voting rights are under attack. So many other fundamental human digni-

ties are under attack. The country looks up to all of us to continue to unite, work together and move forward," he said.

AAPI Salute to Service 2022, which took place after a two-year hiatus due to the

pandemic, included participation by a South Asian partner organization for the first time this year.

"This is the first time I've participated in an event where our community has been honored, and the service and sacrifice recognized of so many in our AAPI community. Gold Star families are represented by many the AAPI community as well," said Shyamali Hauth, U.S. Air Force veteran and SAFA Northwest Regional Director. "We are patriots, every single one of us. And we love our country."

Harini Krishnan, National Organizing Chair for South Asians for America, said the event was, "a reminder to the larger public that we have members of our



Biden Nominates Arati Prabhakar to Lead Science and Tech Policy

WASHINGTON, DC - President Joe Biden has nominated Dr. Arati Prabhakar to serve as Director of the Office of Science and Technology Policy, and once confirmed to this position, also as Assistant to the President for Science and Technology.

In this capacity, Dr. Prabhakar will be the President's Chief Advisor for Science and Technology, a co-chair of the President's Council of Advisors on Science and Technology, and a member of the President's Cabinet, the White House said.

"Dr. Prabhakar is a brilliant and highly-respected engineer and applied physicist and will lead the Office of Science and Technology Policy to leverage science, technology, and innovation to expand our possibilities, solve our toughest challenges, and make the impossible possible," said President Biden. "I share Dr. Prabhakar's belief that America has the most powerful innovation machine the world has ever seen."

Prabhakar has been unanimously confirmed by the Senate before,



to lead the National Institute of Standards and Technology and was the first woman to hold that role. She later served as director of the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency, the birthplace of breakthrough technologies like stealth aircraft and the Internet.

If confirmed to lead OSTP, Prabhakar would become the third Asian American, to serve in President Biden's Cabinet, joining Vice President Kamala Harris and U.S. Trade Representative Katherine Tai.

Prabhakar was unanimously confirmed by the U.S. Senate to lead the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST), taking the helm at age 34 as the first woman to lead the agency. Between her Federal leadership roles, Prabhakar spent 15 years in Silicon Val-

ley, helping bring R&D to deployment as a company executive and as a venture capitalist. Her work included components for consumer electronics and semiconductor process technology.

In 2019, she founded Actuate, a non-profit organization bringing new actors to the table to develop solutions to the challenges of climate, health, trustworthy data and information technology.

Prabhakar's family immigrated from India to the US when she was three years old - first to Chicago and then settling when she was age 10 in Lubbock, TX, where she went on to get her electrical engineering degree from Texas Tech University. She was the first woman to earn a Ph.D. in applied physics from the California Institute of Technology, where she also earned an M.S. in electrical engineering. She started her career in the legislative branch as a Congressional Fellow at the Office of Technology Assessment.

Congress Waives Sanctions

India for Russia Missile Purchases

WASHINGTON, DC - The US House of Representatives on July 14 passed a legislative measure that will urge the Biden administration to waive sanctions on India for purchasing Russian S-400 missile defense systems.

The measure passed in a voice vote as an amendment to the National Defense Authorization Act for fiscal year 2023 (the defense budget). To make it to President Joe Biden's desk for enactment, it must be a part of the final legislation that comes out of a process called reconciliation in which bills passed by the House and Senate are made into one.

India is potentially facing US sanctions under the Countering America's Adversaries Through Sanctions Act (CAATSA) for its purchase of the Russian 3-400s. The 2017 law seeks to punish Russia for the 2016 election interference and other issues by scaring away buyers of its defense equipment with the threat of secondary sanctions. China and Turkey, a NATO ally, are the only two countries sanctioned by the US under this law yet.

India has started receiving these systems, which technically should have triggered CAATSA sanctions, but the Biden administration has



not publicly declared its intentions, either way. The amendment that passed was introduced by CA Congressman Ro Khanna, who is now believed to be considering a run for the White House in 2024 if Biden decides to not run again.

"The United States must stand with India in the face of escalating aggression from China. As Vice Chair of the India Caucus, I have been working to strengthen the partnership between our countries and ensure that India can defend itself along the Indian Chinese border," Khanna said in a statement. "This amendment is of the utmost importance, and I am proud to see it pass the House on a bipartisan basis."

The amendment says India relies on Russian weapons because it faces "immediate and serious regional border threats" from China. And the US should take further steps to encourage India to accelerate its "transition off Russian-built weapons and defense systems".

Leadership Race Mirrors Britain's Growing Diversity

LONDON - It could be called democracy's diversity, or even colonialism's counterblast. The race to succeed UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson by becoming the new leader of the Conservative Party, which espoused the Empire, imperialism, and British national identity has been swamped with contenders from former colonies in Asia and Africa. And at the end of the preliminary rounds, the son of immigrants from British East Africa was on top.

Rishi Sunak, UK's former Chancellor of the Exchequer, or Finance Minister, whose sudden resignation set in motion the circumstances that forced an intransigent Johnson to finally bow out, has emerged as the main contender at the end of four rounds of voting by the 358 Conservative MPs.

Picking up a quarter of the votes in the first round, he became the only one to get over three digits in the second round -- and is followed by three women present and former ministers.

The initial race had an ethnically diverse list of candidates

-- British Pakistani ministers Sajid Javid and Rehman Chishti, Sunak's Iraqi Kurd-born successor Nadhim Zahawi, Attorney General Suella Braverman, whose family's roots are in Goa, and Nigerian-origin former minister Kemi Badenoch.

Sunak and Braverman's fellow Indian-origin Priti Patel, the Home Secretary, chose to sit it out.

Suave, efficient, but also controversy-ridden, the former US-based investment banker, hedge fund operator, and three-time MP still has a chance to become the first non-ethnic Briton to become Prime Minister. Born in South-hampton on May 12, 1980, Sunak is the son of (the then British) Kenya-born Yashvir Sunak and his wife, Tanganyika-born Usha, who grandparents were born in the Punjab Province of British India, and migrated to East Africa, and from there to the UK in the 1960s.

"My parents emigrated here, so you've got this generation of people who are born here, their parents were not born here, and they've come to this country to make a life," he said in an interview with the BBC in 2019. "In terms of cultural upbringing, I'd be at the temple at the weekend

-- I'm a Hindu -- but I'd also be at (Southampton Football Club) the Saints game as well on a Saturday -- you do everything, you do both," he said, also revealing that he was fortunate not to have endured a lot of racism growing up, save for one incident, when he was with his younger siblings.

With his father a general practitioner, and his mother, a pharmacist, he had an easy childhood. He studied at a prep school in Hampshire, and then he was at the prestigious Winchester College, where he was head boy and editor of the school paper; during vacations, he worked at local curry restaurant.

Oxford was the next stop and he graduated in 2001. The same year, he was interviewed along with his parents for the BBC documentary "Middle Classes: Their Rise and Sprawl". He was an analyst at investment bank Goldman Sachs till 2004, and then a hedge fund management firm till 2009, when he left to join former colleagues at a new hedge fund launched in October 2010.

In 2009, he married Akshata, daughter of Infosys founder N.R. Narayana Murthy and writer

Sudha Murthy, who's also the chairperson of the Infosys Foundation. Sunak and Akshata have two daughters.

Engaged with the Conservative Party since his Oxford days, Sunak got into politics full-time in 2014 when he was selected for the Richmond seat in north Yorkshire -- one of the safest Conservative seats, which has been held by the party for more than a century -- and won it in the 2015 elections by nearly 20,000 votes.

A staunch proponent of "Leave" in the Brexit referendum of 2016 and subsequent parliamentary votes, Sunak's first government job was Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Local Gov-

ernment (2018-19) in the Theresa May government and then as Chief Secretary to the Treasury (2019-20) in the government of Johnson, whose leadership bid he had supported.

He replaced his boss Javid as Chancellor of the Exchequer in 2020, and while he mostly earned plaudits for steering the government's economic response to the effects of the Covid-19 lockdown, he also became the first Chancellor to be found to have broken the law while in office by breaching lockdown norms. His wife's non-domicile status, which let her save huge amount of taxes in the country, also became a major controversy for him.

Sri Lanka Gets New President but Not Calm



COLOMBO (IANS) - Ranil Wickremesinghe, who was sworn in as Sri Lanka's eighth President on July 21, vowed to crackdown on protesters who took over President's House and Prime Minister's Office.

Wickremesinghe, who was elected with 134 votes in the parliament said "forcibly occupying the President's Office and the Prime Minister's Office under the guise of engaging in the people's struggle was illegal."

He vowed that legal action would be initiated against those who occupied the President and PM's offices by force.

Wickremesinghe informed party leaders that he intends to prorogue parliament for 24 hours for a "fresh ceremonial start".

The protesters, who occupied the entrance to the President's Office for more than three months and later took over President's Office with a violent clash on July 9 and Prime Minister's office on July



13, had launched a fresh protest against Wickremesinghe claiming they would not accept his Presidency. The protesters see Wickremesinghe as an ally of ousted President Gotabaya Rajapaksa and charged that many MPs were bought over to vote for him.

As soon as Wickremesinghe was elected, police obtained a court order to remove the tents of the protesters occupied in the Galle Face Green. Hours after Wickremesinghe was elected,

protesters who gathered to the entrance of President's Secretariat closer to the main protest site, announced that the unending protest would continue until Wickremesinghe is ousted.

Sri Lankan people, suffering with a massive economic crisis with no fuel, food and medicine, took to the streets on March 31 and continued street fights until former Prime Minister Mahinda Rajapaksa and his cabinet resigned on May 9 and on July 9

President Gotabaya Rajapaksa announced his exit.

On May 13, then President Gotabaya Rajapaksa had appointed Wickremesinghe as the Prime Minister of the country after the then Prime Minister Mahinda Rajapaksa resigned as the country was trying to fight out the economic crisis. After Gotabaya Rajapaksa fled the crisis-hit country, Wickremesinghe was appointed as the acting President of the country.





Dr. Hiro Badlani, a retired ophthalmologist from Mumbai, India has written this latest book in a series of his earlier books on the same subject Hinduism. The book has underlined in bold print at the end of each chapter the evolutionary changes that have taken place periodically from almost the beginning, and also continue to maintain this vibrant character till date! Even so in Hindu culture, the old are always revered and not openly defied and antagonized. Old philosophies, rituals and customs have sustained alongside new ones, leaving individuals to decide for themselves as per their personal choices. It is not uncommon in a Hindu family for members to worship different deities. Differences also exist in choosing various rituals and religious practices. The book highlights this dynamic nature of Hinduism.

It is imperative to realize that Hinduism was not started by one single founder. It is rather like a conglomeration of the spiritual wisdom of many ethnic tribes that inhabited the Indian subcontinent in the ancient period. Thus it absorbed the "pluralistic" character at the very beginning. In accommodating the opinions and beliefs of many, it also acquired the character of becoming non-dogmatic and unbiased. This attitude has been maintained in the Hindu psyche throughout centuries. Religious masters and "Rishis" have repeatedly prompted to maintain harmony and peace, and to look at all beings as creatures of one divine family - "Vasudhaiva Kutumbkum". In the earliest of the Hindu scriptures. the Rig Veda, another foremost principle has been inscribed, "Ekan Sat, Viprah Bahuti", which translates as "There is one Truth, the paths leading to it may be many". The book emphasizes repeatedly on these ancient Vedic philosophies.

The book is presented in chronological order, starting from the pre-historic period, extending from over 10,000 years from now till the present period. The book is freely available at Amazon.com and iUniverse USA.

Murmu scooped up over 50 percent of the total vote value after just three rounds of counting, though the trends became clear after the first round where Murmu stood at 39 percent.

The winner of the Presidential election is not the candidate who gets only the most votes, but the one who crosses a quota. This quota is determined by adding votes polled for each candidate, divided by two, and adding '1' to it. Basically, one more than 50

percent. Counting of votes for the Presidential poll started on July 21 at Parliament House here.

"I heartily congratulate Droupadi Murmu on her victory in the Presidential Election 2022. I hope -- indeed, every Indian hopes -- that as the 15th President of India, she functions as the Custodian of the Constitution without fear or favor. I join my fellow countrymen in extending best wishes to her," said Sinha while conceding defeat.

"At a time when 1.3 billion Indians are marking Azadi Ka Amrit

Mahotsav, a daughter of India hailing from a tribal community born in a remote part of eastern India has been elected our President. Congratulations to Droupadi Murmu ji on this feat," Prime Minister Narendra Modi tweeted.

"Droupadi Murmu ji's life, her early struggles, her rich service, and her exemplary success motivates each and every Indian. She has emerged as a ray of hope for our citizens, especially the poor, marginalized and the downtrodden," he said.

Immediately after June 21 when she was nominated by the NDA, Murmu's victory seemed certain and her numbers got a boost with support from some opposition parties including the Biju Janata Dal, Shiv Sena, Jharkhand Mukti Morcha, YSR Congress, Bahujan Samaj Party and Telegu Desam Party. Murmu will be sworn into office on July 25 replacing Ram Nath Kovind.



Festive Mood in Hometown

BHUBANESWAR, (IANS) - With NDA's Presidential nominee Droupadi Murmu securing the majority mark to be elected as the 15th President of India, people at her hometown Rairangpur in Odisha's Mayurbhanj district burst into celebrations on July 21.

As Ranveer is all set to turn 37 on July 6, Shankar surprised him by singing a happy birthday song during the concert. In the video, the whole crowd






