Trump Deportations:

Anger In India, US Official Posts, "You Will Be Removed"

NEW DELHI - Illegal Indian immigrants deported by the US arrived on February 6 at the Ahmedabad airport here. A US military C-17 Globemaster aircraft carrying deported Indian nationals had landed in Amritsar on February 5, carrying 104 expelled Indian nationals.

The deportations have sparked anger and concern among political leaders and families of the returnees. Punjab NRI Affairs Minister Kuldeep Singh Dhaliwal expressed his frustration, urging Prime Minister Narendra Modi to intervene. "Modiji calls Trump (former US President Donald Trump) his friend. I request PM Modi ji to speak to Trump to find a solution to this issue," he stated.

Family members of the deported individuals reacted with a mix of

relief and anxiety. One relative in Vadodara said, "I don't know much. My daughter is back. We learned through the media that this was going to happen. I am just happy she is home safely." Another family member lamented the lack of communication, stating, "No one informed me. My son, daughterin-law, and grandchild were there. They never spoke to me on the phone. People are saying they will return, but I don't know anything."

Addressing the matter in Parliament, External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar said it was India's responsibility to take Contd. on P27

Chandrika Tandon **Wins Grammy**

LOS ANGELES, CA - Chennaiborn Chandrika Tandon has made history by winning a Grammy Award for Best New Age, Ambient, or Chant Album at the 67th Annual Grammy Awards. Tandon, a 71-year-old New York-based businesswoman and musician, received the honor for her album Triveni, a unique fusion of ancient mantras and world music. The award was presented during the ceremony held at the Crypto.com Arena here on February 3.

This Grammy win marks Tandon's first victory and second nomination, following her 2010 nod for Om Namo Narayana: Soul Call. This year, she was nominated alongside notable artists including producer Ricky Kej, sitar player Anoushka Shankar, and Indian-origin British artist Radhika Vekaria.

Outrageous: Anti-Indian, Racist Staffer To Be Rehired By Musk

WASHINGTON, DC-Elon Musk, acting with impunity as a nonelected official, has announced that he would rehire Marko Elez, a former Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE) employee, who had been previously fired for posting racist comments. The decision came after Elez resigned on February 6, following revelations of the offensive posts, which were uncovered by The Wall Street Journal.

One of the posts, made in Sep-

tember, stated, "Normalize Indian hate," while another said, "You could not pay me to marry outside of my ethnicity." Musk, who runs X, conducted a poll asking whether Elez should be rehired, and 78% of his predictably MAGA respondents voted in favor of bringing him back.

Musk's decision to rehire Elez followed a supportive statement from Vice President JD Vance, who shared Musk's post on X, which read, "He will be brought back. To err is human, to forgive divine." Vance, while express-

ing disagreement with some of Elez's posts, argued, "I don't think stupid social media activity should ruin a kid's life," suggesting that Elez should only be fired if he was truly a "bad dude or a terrible member of the team."

Vance's comments have drawn further attention due to his wife, Usha Vance, being of Indian origin. She is the first Indian American Second Lady of the United States.

However, Vance's support for Musk's decision was met with criticism from Congressman

Ro Khanna. Khanna questioned whether Elez would apologize for his racist post before being rehired, calling out the lack of accountability for Elez's actions. "If you are going to rehire someone to represent you & the USA, why not insist he apologize for saying 'Normalize Indian hate?'" Khanna emphasized.

Vance responded, defending his position by arguing that it is not "racist trolls" who threaten his children but a culture that fails to offer grace to those who make

DC Mid-Air Collision: 2 Indian Americans Killed

WASHINGTON, DC - Two Indian Americans, Asra Hussain Raza and Vikesh Patel, were among the 67 victims killed in the horrific mid-air collision near Washington, D.C., on January 29. The collision, involving American Airlines Flight 5342 and an Army Black Hawk helicopter, occurred as the aircraft were approaching Ronald Reagan National Airport. The tragic incident is the deadliest aviation disaster in the U.S. since 2001.

Asra Hussain Raza, a 26-year-old Washington, D.C.based consultant, was on the flight for a work trip related to hospital

turnaround projects. The daughter of Indian immigrants, Raza was remembered by her father-in-law, Dr. Hashim Raza, as someone who always went above and beyond for others. "She was always someone who went out of her way for others," he recalled, reflecting on how she would stay on late-night calls to keep him company during emergency room shifts.

Raza, a 2020 graduate of Indiana University with honors, had recently married her college sweetheart, Hamaad Raza, in August 2023. Her husband shared the devastating moment when he learned of the crash, revealing that she had texted him just 20 minutes before the flight's scheduled landing. "By the time I got to the airport, my life had changed forever," he said, recounting how emergency vehicles rushed past him as his texts to her went unanswered.

Vikesh Patel, a long-time employee at GE Aerospace, was also aboard the flight. Larry Culp, CEO of GE Aerospace, confirmed Patel's death, expressing the company's grief. "This is a tragedy not only for our industry but also for the GE Aerospace team," Culp said in a statement.

Patel, who had recently transitioned to the role of MRO Transformational Leader, had worked for GE Aerospace for over a decade in various capacities, including as an engine assembly engineer, production planner, and senior operations manager. He was returning home after work related travel.

The outpouring on social media by fellow staffers and friends remembering and mourning Patel was immediate with many recalling his character and professionalism.



Recent actions taken by the Trump administration involving the removal and disruption of key federal public datasets have underscored a fundamental truth: Data is so essential, yet its value is not perceived until it is taken away.

Data informs everything we do from the efficiency of daily business transactions to the effective delivery of various public services. Scientists and policy makers alike rely on public data to understand the causes and consequences of pressing issues, and to produce solutions involving the public and private sectors alike.

And visibility and recognition in data has been a decades-long priority for the Asian American, Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander communities that we serve. Indeed, as researchers have noted, data disaggregation is a civil rights issue for Asian Americans, ensuring access to critical benefits and protections.

Here are six essential ways that good data is foundational to our country's success:

1. Data Expertise is Critical for America's Economic Success

Threats To Public Data Harm All Americans

Data science is quickly growing in popularity across the nation, and statistics has long been a requirement for business, economics, and many other social sciences.

- The World Economic Forum's Future of Jobs Report indicates that Big Data Specialists will see the biggest growth in demand over the next five years.
- The U.S. Department of Labor also notes strong demand and high salaries for data scientists in the coming years.


2. Good Data is Critical for America's Global Competitiveness

The United States continues to remain one of the most dynamic economies in the world, and "good data" plays a critical role in powering the country's competitiveness.

- The U.S. Chamber of Commerce notes that data "has long been a driver of the United States' 21st century economic leadership."
- Population data plays a critical role in informing business decisions, large and small—from stock market trends to the expansion plans of many small businesses.

3. Good Data Ensures Community Health and Well Being

Population health data helps us

understand who is disproportionately affected by various diseases, such as Hepatitis B, and how investments and treatments may need to vary across communities.

• The removal of health related data across federal agencies prevents physicians and hospitals from effectively serving their populations.

4. Government Efficiency is Impossible Without Good Data

Reliable and accurate data is critical for improving government efficiency. The removal of population data collections harms the effectiveness of public programs.

• Population data on language needs in rural counties helps emergency rooms run better. Translated documents reduce the likelihood of costly medical mistakes.

• Data on community health needs helps local governments better plan for staffing specialty care across various neighborhoods.

5. Data is Essential to Track and End Discrimination

Data on race, ethnicity, gender, disability and veteran status are critical to ensuring successful implementation of various anti-discrimination laws, including the Civil Rights Act and the Voting Rights Act to the Americans with Disabilities Act, and the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA).

• Federal agencies should be pushing for improvements in these data collections, including making them more timely and accessible to the public.

6. Removing Public Data Amounts to Government Cen-

sorship

The Trump White House issued an executive order entitled "Restoring Freedom of Speech and Ending Federal Censorship." The executive order states, "Government censorship of speech is intolerable in a free society." We agree.

- Freedom of speech is critical to government accountability, civic engagement, and journalistic integrity.
- Data is foundational to these values as it enables an informed public discourse. The removal of data from federal government websites amounts to government censorship.

Simply put, good data is fundamental to upholding America's success, its laws and its values. We are less safe as a nation when 8,000+ web pages and population health databases went missing across many federal agencies.

Regardless of one's political ideology, we must fight for the sanctity and integrity of good data.

White Supremacists And The Far Right Are The Real Threat To America's Security

Donald Trump's continued attacks on immigrants as criminals divert attention and, critically, resources from the very real threat posed by white supremacists and far right violence.

Donald Trump has ridden the xenophobic political tiger into the White House once again, convincing Americans that immigrants in this country are an existential threat to our safety and the wellbeing of the nation.

It's a politically effective trope that in practice diverts attention and, critically, resources from the very real threat posed by white supremacists and far right violence.

"This is a problem that infects all our society," says Mike German, a former FBI agent who spent years undercover working to expose far right and white supremacist groups operating within law enforcement. "It is not a matter that pops up once in a while. It is a constant problem."

Despite Trump's continued lambasting of migrants as criminals, rapists and thieves—descriptions used to justify his campaign of mass deportations—data show that as a group, immigrants, legal or otherwise, commit far fewer crimes than American born citizens, and in fact may have an overall mitigating effect on crime.

Violence and terrorism committed by adherents of white supremacist and far right ideologies, on the other hand, have been rising steadily over the past decade, surpassing threats posed by Islamist extremists and other ideologically motivated groups, jeopardizing public safety and even the foundations of our democracy.

And, says German, the pervasiveness of white supremacist and far right ideologies within local, state and federal law enforcement agencies, including the agency he once worked for, makes this threat all the more pernicious.

The starkest example of that threat is the January 6, 2020, attack on the US Capitol. "Many people were shocked when so many police were involved," notes German. "But there were military officials, and elected representatives also involved," he said, a sign of just how widespread these ideas have become within agencies and offices ostensibly in charge of protecting the public.

One of Trump's first actions in office was to pardon participants in the

January 6 assault, a move German says is an "an acknowledgement that he is not on law enforcement's side." Some 174 police officers were injured and one later died following the attack.

An investigation by Reuters in 2022 painted an alarming portrait of "white supremacist infiltration within law enforcement," as well as ties between officers and instructors, with extremist groups including the Proud Boys and the Oath Keepers, both of which are linked to the events of Jan. 6.

German traces a through line from the creation of the Department of Justice in 1870 specifically intended to target racist violence perpetrated by the Ku Klux Klan to the emergence of Jim Crow laws designed to uphold white supremacy.

"People tend to forget that US law

enforcement systems built at this time were meant to enforce white supremacy," he says. "This is why it is so persistent in policing today."

It also explains why important signals warning of possible violence on Jan. 6 were missed or ignored by law enforcement. "For a long time, the FBI had not prioritized investigations of far-right violence. They focused on anarchists, anti-fascists, and even environmentalists. Groups that were far less violent," says German.

Neither the FBI nor the Department of Homeland Security collect data on acts of domestic terrorism committed by white supremacists and the far right, he adds, often ascribing them to "lone wolves" rather than acknowledging "what is a more networked movement."



Covered California Reaching Out To Fire Victims

SACRAMENTO, CA – Covered California has announced a special-enrollment period for residents of Los Angeles and Ventura counties, where a state of emergency has been declared due to the Palisades and Eaton Fires that have destroyed over 12,000 homes and displaced hundreds of thousands of Californians.

"These fires have caused unprecedented destruction and have upended the lives of so many living in Southern California," said Covered California Executive Director Jessica Altman. "Everyone who is uninsured and has been affected by these fires, directly or indirectly, will have an extended opportunity to obtain health insurance through Covered California or Medi-Cal over the next two months."

Californians have 60 days from the date that the state of emergency was declared in their county to sign up for coverage, so this special-enrollment period will last until March 8.

Special Enrollment Will Continue to Offer Expanded Financial Help for 2025

Those signing up for coverage will be eligible for more financial help than ever before, as Covered California has enhanced its cost-sharing reduction program for 2025. These cost-sharing reductions lessen the cost of accessing health care by lowering out-of-pocket costs when they seek medical care, including eliminat-



ing deductibles in all three Silver cost-sharing reduction plans.

The cost-sharing reduction

program for out-of-pocket costs is available to all Californians with incomes above 200 percent

For details

of the federal poverty level (which is \$30,120 for a single person and \$62,400 for a family of four), while those under 200 percent of the federal poverty level will continue to have access to higher levels of benefits.

Nearly 90 percent of Covered California's

over 1.8 million enrollees receive financial help. Two-thirds of those enrollees are eligible for health insurance for \$10 or less per month, and nearly half could get a comprehensive Silver plan for that price.

"The rebuilding of these wonderful communities of Los Angeles will be a massive undertaking, but we know Southern Californians are resilient and ready for the challenges ahead," Altman said. "Rebuilding will take time and persistence, but investing in your mental and physical health is fundamental. As you begin to reconstruct your homes and lives, know that health care is within reach and Covered California is here to help."

Coming into open enrollment, data from the California Simulation of Insurance Markets (CalSIM), a model created by the UCLA Center for Health Policy Research, showed that of the 1.3 million uninsured Californians who qualify for subsidies through Covered California or are eligible for Medi-Cal coverage, 356,000 of them reside in Southern California.

Fresno City Becomes First In US To Name School After A Sikh

FRESNO, CA – Fresno's Central Unified School District has made history by naming a new elementary school after a Sikh. The school board voted 6-1 on January 28 to name the new campus, located at Shields and Brawley avenues, Jaswant Singh Khalra Elementary. When it opens in August 2025, it will be the first public school in North America

named after a person of Sikh descent, a media release said.

The district serves a large Punjabi Sikh community, with 1,700 students—10.55% of the total student population—identifying as Punjabi/ Southeast Asian, according to The Fresno Bee. Punjabi students are expected to make up 9% of the new school's enrollment, it added.

Jaswant Singh Khalra Elementary will be Central Unified's 15th elementary school, with a capacity

of over 600 students from preschool to sixth grade. The campus will include a multi-purpose building with an outdoor amphitheater, play courts, and modern baseball, softball, and soccer fields.

Calling the vote a "historic moment", Central Unified School District Board of Trustees President Naindeep Singh Chann, in a statement said he was proud to support the naming alongside Trustees Nabil Kherfan, Yesenia Z. Carillo, Karla Kirk, Jaspreet Singh Sidhu, and Natalie Chavez.

Khalra was a bank director in Amritsar, who in the early 1990s dedicated himself to investigating the disappearances and extrajudicial killings by Punjab police. His daughter, Navkiran Kaur Khalra, is a Fresno State alumna who now works in the Bay Area. In 2017, Fresno honored Khalra's legacy by naming a park after him, located about two miles from the new school.

Popular Punjabi singer and actor Diljit Dosanjh took to Instagram to celebrate the recognition, calling the move "historic." Dosanjh is set to bring Khalra's story to the big screen in an upcoming biopic Punjab 95, where he will portray the late human rights activist who was abducted and murdered in 1995. It led to the conviction and sentencing of six Punjab police officials later. Punjab 95 is set for an international release on Feb. 7.

SoCal Edison Says Its Equipment Might Have Caused LA Fires

LOS ANGELES, CA – Southern California Edison (SCE), a subsidiary of Edison International, is investigating whether its equipment contributed to the ignition of two wildfires in the Los Angeles area.

The wildfires, including the Eaton Fire, began on January 7, causing significant damage, including fatalities and destruction of homes. SCE operates in areas affected by the Eaton Fire, which is under investigation.

SCE stated that recent evidence, such as videos from external parties, suggests a potential connection to its equipment. However, the company emphasized that no definitive signs—such as broken conductors or burn marks—have been found

to indicate its equipment caused the fire.

The company plans to conduct a physical inspection of transmission lines in the Altadena area as part of its investigation, which is expected to take several months.

SCE also provided an update on the Hurst Fire, which started near Tower 6 north of Saddle Ridge Road. The cause of that fire is still under investigation, and the company is cooperating with fire investigators, it said. The Hurst Fire, reported on January 7, was contained by January 16, after burning approximately 799 acres.

SCE, along with other electric utilities, is facing increased scrutiny following these wild-fires, which are expected to be the costliest natural disaster in U.S. history.



NEW YORK, NY – Adani Green has hired independent law firms to review a U.S. indictment against founder Gautam Adani and senior executives for allegedly paying \$265 million in bribes to secure power contracts. The company, in a regulatory filing on January 23, emphasized its compliance with applicable laws but did not disclose the law firms' names.

The indictment, filed in November 2024, charges Adani, his nephew Sagar Adani, and Managing Director Vneet S. Jaain with bribery and misleading U.S. investors. The case centers around a 2021 solar energy deal in Andhra Pradesh, awarded under questionable circumstances. Adani Green has denied the bribery allegations, calling them "baseless."

While the company is not named as a defendant, concerns about the charges have led to some partners and investors reassessing their involvement, with TotalEnergies halting further investments in the Adani Group. Adani Green's shares have dropped over 27% since the indictment was made public.



Gunjan Kedia Becomes First Woman CEO Of U.S. Bancorp

MINNEAPOLIS, MN - Gunjan Kedia has been named the next chief executive officer of U.S. Bancorp, becoming one of the most influential women in the financial sector. The company announced on January 28 that Kedia, currently president, will take over as CEO following the annual shareholders meeting on April 15. She will also join the Board of Directors.

Kedia, 54, will succeed Andy Cecere, who will transition to executive chairman while continuing to lead the board and supporting Kedia in her new role.

Before U.S. Bancorp, she held global executive roles at

State Street Financial and BNY Mellon and worked in leadership positions at McKinsey & Company and PwC.

Recognized as a seven-time honoree on American Banker's Most Powerful Women in Banking and Finance list, Kedia has also been named twice to Barron's 100 Most Influential Women in U.S. Finance list.

In addition to her financial expertise, she serves on the boards of PBS, the American Red Cross, and Carnegie Mellon Business



School. She holds an MBA from Carnegie Mellon University and a bachelor's degree from the Delhi School of Engineering. Kedia emphasized the bank's commitment to integrity and innovation as she prepares to take the helm.

"U.S. Bancorp is a truly special place that allows us to do meaningful work and build lasting relationships with millions of clients," Kedia said. "We will build on a solid foundation of integrity and doing business the right way to drive growth."

Aravind Srinivas Challenges Elon Musk To Stop His \$500B Fundraising From USAID

SAN FRANCISCO, CA – Aravind Srinivas, CEO of the AI search engine Perplexity AI, has openly challenged Tesla owner Elon Musk to prevent him from raising \$500 billion from the U.S. Agency for In-

ternational Development (USAID).

"Considering raising \$500B from USAID. Funding secured. Stop me if you can @elonmusk. What

is USAID?" Srinivas posted on X (formerly Twitter).

This post came days after both Musk and former President Donald Trump called for the closure of USAID. On February 7, a federal judge temporarily paused the administration's plan to put 2,200 USAID workers on paid leave, adding to the ongoing controversy surrounding the agency's future.

31-year old Srinivas, who cofounded Perplexity AI in 2022, is no stranger to the tech world. An alumnus of IIT-Madras and the University of California, Berkeley, Srinivas previously worked at OpenAI, Google, and DeepMind, before returning to OpenAI as a research scientist.

Perplexity AI, backed by high-profile investors like Jeff Bezos, has quickly established itself as a leading AI-powered search engine.



Srinivas's challenge to Musk comes as both Musk and Trump criticize USAID, with Trump calling it a "criminal organization" and Musk describing it as being "run by radical

lunatics." While protests have occurred in Washington, DC, against the idea of dismantling the agency, Srinivas is using the moment to draw attention to his own ambitious fundraising plans, setting the stage for a high-profile clash with Musk.

In the past, the two have had cordial interactions regarding

immigration and the Chennai born Srinivas getting his green card. Recently he had tweeted, "Excited for Elon and Vivek to make legal immigration bet-

ter. I would even

push for a higher application fee (eg 2x) in exchange for high quality fast service. Think about immigration to America as you investing in the country. Should be as simple as you uploading documents from a mobile app, Apple Pay, interview scheduled in a week, and results arriving to you in a month."

Caltech's Anima Anandkumar, Arvind Krishna Of IBM Among TIME's AI Impact Award Winners

NEW YORK, NY - Two Indian Americans, Arvind Krishna and Anima Anandkumar, have been recognized among the winners of the 2025 TIME100 AI Impact Awards, which honor global leaders shaping the future of artificial intelligence. The award, introduced in 2022, celebrates individuals who are using AI to revolutionize industries, solve complex problems, and drive meaningful change.

Anima Anandkumar: Pioneering AI for Scientific Discovery

Caltech professor Anima Anandkumar is at the forefront of integrating AI with scientific research, accelerating discoveries across physics, medicine, and climate science wrote Tharin Pillay. Her work centers on "neural operators," a revolutionary AI framework that models complex physical systems with unparalleled speed and accuracy.

Anandkumar's breakthroughs include the AI-driven weather model FourCastNet, which generates highly accurate week-long forecasts in seconds-thousands of

times faster than conventional models. The technology has already proven its value in predicting extreme weather events like Hurricane Beryl in 2024.


Her AI-driven simulations extend to nuclear fusion, where she and her team collaborated with the U.K. Atomic Energy Agency to model plasma behavior a million times faster than existing techniques. This innovation helps predict and prevent potentially disastrous disruptions in fusion reactors, bringing the world closer to sustainable clean energy.

Beyond physics, Anandkumar's AI models have made significant contributions to healthcare. In 2023, she helped design a catheter that reduces bacterial contamination a hundredfold, potentially lowering the risk of infections for over a million patients annually.

Arvind Krishna: Steering IBM Toward Specialized AI

IBM CEO Arvind Krishna has positioned the company as a leader in specialized AI, prioritizing efficiency and targeted applications

over the massive, resource-intensive models favored by competitors like OpenAI and Google. Under his leadership, IBM has focused on creating smaller, more costeffective AI tools tailored to specific industries, allowing businesses to enhance productivity without the need for billion-dollar investments in general-purpose AI models said writer and Billy Perrigo.

Krishna's strategy gained vali-

dation when the Chinese AI lab DeepSeek released an efficient open-source model in early 2025, raising concerns about the longterm profitability of large-scale AI ventures. Around the same time, IBM announced a 10% increase in AI-driven software sales, surpassing market expectations and boosting its stock to an all-time high of \$240 billion.

Beyond AI, Krishna is betting

big on quantum computing, a field IBM has heavily invested in. He predicts that by 2030, quantum breakthroughs will revolutionize industries much like mainframes and personal computers did in the past. If successful, Krishna believes IBM could reclaim its dominance in the tech sector, establishing itself as the go-to leader in quantum and AI-driven solutions.





CA Burglary Ring Targeting Asian Americans Busted; 3 Arrested

SAN JOSE, CA – San José Police Chief Paul Joseph announced on January 22, the arrests of three suspects linked to a sophisticated burglary ring that deliberately targeted Asian American households across the Bay Area. The group is believed to be responsible for 78 burglaries since June 2024, with the stolen property valued at approximately \$1 million.

The arrests of Alberto Ibarra Vallejo, 25; Gonzalo Valencia Ramos, 28; and Jaime Martinez Arroyo, 46, followed months of investigation involving multiple law enforcement agencies across Northern and Central California. The suspects were taken into custody on January 16 with assistance from Stockton police SWAT officers. They remain in custody without bail and are set to appear in court on February 3.

During the raids, authorities recovered 700 stolen items, including wedding rings, luxury watches, jewelry, and family heirlooms. Police also seized five firearms, three of which were confirmed stolen.

Methodical Targeting of AAPI Households

Police allege that the suspects systematically cased neighbor-



hoods in West San José, Cupertino, Saratoga, Campbell, and Mountain View, specifically targeting Asian American households. San José Mayor Matt Mahan described the emotional toll on the community saying, "For roughly six months, our AAPI community in the West San José region has lived in fear as home after home has been broken into and residents have wondered if they were next."

The burglars reportedly avoided large items like televisions or electronics, instead opting for high-value goods such as jewelry, cash, high-end purses, and foreign currency. items, making them prime targets.

Coordination Among Agencies Led to Arrests

Chief Joseph revealed that frag-

mented investigations initially hindered progress, as different agencies pursued the cases individually. The breakthrough came when a suspect was identified on a doorbell camera by Santa Clara County Sheriff's detectives. This recognition led to a coordinated effort by multiple agencies, including the San José Police Department, to track the suspects and execute search warrants.

"Extensive surveillance and search warrants conducted by San José PD led us to uncover additional suspects involved in this prolific burglary operation," Joseph said.

Authorities continue to investigate the possibility of additional crew members and expect the number of linked burglaries to rise.

Tech Entrepreneur Vishnu Hari Assaulted, Seriously Injured

SAN FRANCISCO – The San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) is investigating an assault in the Mission District that left tech entrepreneur Vishnu Hari seriously injured.

At approximately 2:08 a.m. on January 18, officers responded to a report of a man bleeding from the head at the intersection of 24th and Bryant Streets. Medics were already on the scene, and the victim, later identified as Vishnu Hari, cofounder of the 3D simulation engine firm Ego, was transported to a local hospital.

Authorities reported that the assault occurred following a dispute with another



individual, which escalated when the suspect struck Hari with a metal pipe. The SFPD has not made any arrests, and the investigation is ongoing.

Hari, who has since been discharged from the intensive care unit, stated on social media that he has no memory of the incident. He is recovering from a traumatic brain injury, partial blindness in his right eye, and hearing impairment in his left ear. He also mentioned that his jewelry was taken during the assault, although his phone and wallet were not.

Elon Recruits UC Berkeley Grad Akash Bobba To DOGE Amid Uproar Over Hiring Of 'Kids'

WASHINGTON, DC – The newly formed Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE), spearheaded by Elon Musk, has drawn scrutiny for its recruitment choices of six engineers ages 19-24 which includes 22-year-old Akash Bobba.

Bobba, a graduate of the University of California, Berkeley, has an impressive technical background despite his age. He previously interned at Meta, focusing on AI, worked at Palantir in data analytics, and contributed to Bridgewater Associates in financial modeling. His problem-solving skills gained attention when a former classmate, Charis Zhang, shared on X that Bobba once rewrote an entire project's codebase overnight after it was accidentally deleted, helping his team secure first place in their class.

SECURITY

Despite his technical expertise, Bobba's role—along with five other young engineers, including a 19-year-old—has raised concerns. According to Wired, at least four members of the team, including Bobba, have received top-level security clearances despite having no



prior government experience. Critics argue that placing individuals with limited knowledge of federal operations in positions with access to sensitive data poses a national security risk.

DOGE's mission is to streamline federal operations, eliminate bureaucratic inefficiencies, and cut billions in government spending, but the department's structure and leadership choices have already caused internal friction. Reports on X suggest that some gov-

ernment agencies resist Musk's team, with allegations that certain DOGE personnel attempted to access classified information at the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID). This reportedly led to security officials being placed on leave.

As controversy swirls around DOGE's unconventional hires, questions remain about oversight, security protocols, and the extent of Musk's influence within the administration.

mistakes. He explained, "They will develop views that they later think are wrong or even gross. I made mistakes as a kid, and thank God I grew up in a culture that encouraged me to grow and learn and feel remorse when I screwed up and offer grace when others did."

In his reply, Khanna reiterated his concerns, stating that grace should not be extended without acknowledgment of wrongdoing. He stressed the importance of an apology before Elez could be trusted with a position of responsibility, particularly given the impact of his offensive remarks on Indian American communities.

The debate over Elez's rehiring drew in Congressman Raja Krishnamoorthi, who expressed his outrage. "There should be no place for racism and hate in our government, within the Department of Government Efficiency, or any other agency, office, or entity," Krishnamoorthi said. "It is appalling that the Vice President of the United States and one of the president's most prominent advisors would rally behind the rehiring of someone who rightly resigned his post upon the revelation of his authorship of social media comments as bigoted as 'Normalize Indian Hate."

Krishnamoorthi continued, emphasizing that true forgiveness requires genuine remorse. "Elon Musk and the Vice President each invoked the need for forgiveness, but true forgiveness can only come when it is sought, when remorse is shown, and when the genuine desire to make amends is demonstrated." He expressed concern that Elez's supporters were too quick to dismiss his hateful remarks as the actions of a "kid," despite Elez's significant position in government.

"The Trump Administration and DOGE should hold themselves to a higher standard," Krishnamoorthi added, "and so should our entire nation."

In response to questions about the controversy, President Donald Trump was asked about the posts made by Elez and whether he agreed with Vance's opinion that Elez should be rehired. Trump responded, "Well, I don't know about the particular thing," during a press conference at the White House with Japanese Prime Minister Shigeru Ishiba. He added, "But if the vice president said that — did you say that? — I'm with the vice president."

Anekant Community Center (ACC), founded in 2005, is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit dedicated to

global humanitarian services, focusing on healthcare, education, nutrition, and disaster relief. Striving to be a multi-service, multi-ethnic resource center, ACC supports underserved communities in Southern California and beyond. It has led fundraisers to provide direct aid for global natural disasters and has promoted Indian culture through events like East meets West (Kathak vs. Jazz), Ustad Nishat Khan's sitar concert, Hasya Kavi Sammelan, and more. ACC also empowers young adults to launch nonprofit initiatives. Managed by a nine-member Board of Directors and many volunteers, ACC operates without paid employees. Key supporters Sarva Mangal Family Trust (SMFT) and Shah Happiness Foundation (SHF) have played a crucial role in contributing to ACC's global humanitarian efforts.

ACC's medical missions began locally with free health fairs at the Jain Center of Southern California (JCSC) in 2005. The city of Anaheim invited ACC to start a health fair in 2007, soon becoming ACC's largest event each year. Now hosting 6 to 8 annual health fairs, ACC offers crucial medical services, including vital sign measurements, blood tests, EKGs, PAP Smears, mammograms, chiropractor consultations, acupuncture, on-site dental procedures, vision screenings, free eyeglasses, and citizenship application assistance. The Nalini Shah Cancer Fund, established in 2008, promotes cancer awareness, education, prevention, and early detection, also organizing camps in Gujarat, India. During COVID-19, ACC provided food with the United Sikh Mission and the Joy of Sharing Foundation; gave Chromebooks to students; and sent oxygen concentrators to India with SMFT, Pratham, and JAINA.

The Tender Care Community Outreach Program (TCCOP), a subsidiary of ACC since 2008, is a volunteer network providing support, assistance, and educational services to local people facing challenges. They offer meals for the homeless, tutor students, give groceries to families in need, fulfill Christmas wish lists, visit patients, and conduct career-prep seminars. At Valadez Middle School in Placentia, TCCOP has donated school supplies, food, blankets, technological devices, eyeglasses, and essential kits.



Globally, ACC has conducted hundreds of missions, impacting hundreds of thousands of lives in 27 countries across 5 continents:

- Asia Hundreds of medical missions in 7 Indian states & 1 in Nepal. Fundraised after natural disasters in India, Japan, Philippines, Nepal, Indonesia, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Malaysia, Iran, & Syria.
- II. North America New Orleans, Canada, Los Angeles, Haiti, Puerto Rico, Mexico, Jamaica
- III. Europe Türkiye, Albania
- IV. Africa Zambia, Malawi, South Africa, Morocco, Libya, Ghana, Nigeria, Cameroon, Kenya, Uganda

In 2024, vision screening and eyeglass distribution missions were conducted in 10 countries, benefiting 165,150 people. ACC addressed vision impairments and anemia, focusing on young girls and women.

ACC prioritizes assisting patients without access to critical healthcare, ensuring a sustainable impact. In 2024, over 5,500 surgeries were performed worldwide, including hernia repairs, hysterectomies, cyst and tumor removals, and cataract surgeries.

1. India

Specifically in India, ACC has led numerous missions. Two recent missions in Chandigarh and Gorakhpur provided medical screenings, specialty consultations, vision screenings, free eyeglasses, anemia testing, and pain management with physical therapy.

ACC also holds annual 3-day surgical camps at Kalidas Hospital in Vyara, offering essential procedures like hernia repair, hydrocele, cyst and lump removal, and hysterectomies. Since 2007, over 3,100 free surgeries have been performed. In 2024, 219 operations were performed.

For over 20 years, ACC has played a crucial role in global disaster relief, responding to earthquakes, floods, pandemics, cyclones, tsunamis, and wildfires, including the recent Los Angeles wildfires. The organization raises and distributes funds, coordinates relief efforts, and delivers essential supplies to affected communities. Since the 2005 Kashmir earthquake, ACC has made disaster recovery a major priority. ACC has provided aid for numerous disasters, including the 2005 Katrina floods, the 2011 Japan tsunami, the 2013 Philippines typhoon, the 2017 Puerto Rico floods, and COVID-19 relief in 2020 and 2021. During COVID-19, ACC donated over 7,000 Chromebooks in association with SMFT and SHF.

Trump Fires Rohit Chopra From Consumer Protection Bureau

WASHINGTON, DC -Rohit Chopra has been removed as Director of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB), ending his five-year term nearly two years early. He was informed of his dismissal via an email from the White House.

Chopra was appointed by former President Joe Biden to lead the CFPB, an agency he helped establish following the 2008-09 financial crisis. As the bureau's deputy director, he played a pivotal role in highlighting rising student loan debt and advocating for consumer protection reforms.

Major consumer banks including Bank of America and JPMorgan Chase are among companies facing lawsuits from the CFPB. They, alongside tech industry leaders, encouraged Trump to remove Chopra from his role, several media outlets reported.

Before heading the CFPB, Chopra served as a Commissioner on the Federal Trade Commission from 2018 to 2021, after being nominated by then President Donald Trump. At the FTC, he pushed for stricter penalties against repeat offenders, opposed no-money, no-fault fraud settlements, and worked to strengthen the "Made in USA" label and fair competition policies.

Chopra's career in consumer protection dates back to his initial tenure at the CFPB from 2010 to 2015. In 2011, he was designated as the agency's first student loan ombudsman by the Secretary of the Treasury, where he focused on student lending issues.



In a letter following his dismissal, Chopra reflected on his tenure, writing, "It has been an extraordinary privilege to serve as Director of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau and as a Member of the Board of Directors of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation since 2021, as well as to serve as a Commissioner on the Federal Trade Commission from 2018 to 2021. I am grateful to both President Biden and President Trump for nominating me and to the United States Senate for confirming me to these positions."

Before entering public service, Chopra worked at McKinsey & Company, specializing in financial services, healthcare, and consumer technology sectors. He holds a BA from Harvard University and an MBA from the Wharton School at the University of Pennsylvania.

Seattle Consulate Calls Cops As Kshama Sawant Protests Visa Denial, India Blacklisting Her

SEATTLE, WA – Indian American politician Kshama Sawant staged a protest outside the Indian consulate here, saying her visa was denied multiple times without explanation. The demonstration led to an altercation, with the Consulate accusing individuals of "unauthorized entry" and calling local authorities to handle the situation without saying too much more.

The Indian Consulate in Seattle, in its social media post on February 6, stated that a "law and order situation" arose when "certain individuals" entered the premises after office hours. "We were compelled to call in relevant local authorities to deal with the situation. Further action is being initiated against the trespassers," the Consulate posted.

Sawant, a former Seattle City Council member and vocal critic of the Indian government, said she was protesting after being repeatedly denied a visa, while her husband, Calvin Priest, was granted an emergency visa to visit her 82-year-old ailing mother in Bengaluru.

"My husband & I are in Seattle Indian consulate. They granted him emergency visa for my mother being very sick. But rejected mine, literally saying my name is on a 'reject list'. And refusing to give explanation why," she posted on her social media handle.

Sawant stated that a consular officer told her she was being denied a visa because she



was on the Indian government's "reject list." She argued that the decision was politically motivated, citing her past actions in Seattle's City Council. Sawant continued her protest, calling it an act of "peaceful civil disobedience" and demanding answers from the Consulate.

In response, the Indian Consulate accused the protesters of refusing to leave and behaving aggressively.

"Despite repeated requests, these individuals refused to leave the Consulate premises and engaged in aggressive and threatening behavior with the Consulate staff," the Consulate stated.

After her decade-long stint with the Seattle City Council, Sawant established Workers Strike Back, which advocates a federal minimum wage of \$25 an hour and unionizing labor in the IT industry.



Thanedar Concerned Over Impact Of Govt. Staff Cuts On Food Safety And Quality Control

India-West News Desk

WASHINGTON, DC – U.S. House Agriculture Committee member Shri Thanedar (MI-D) expressed concerns to Brownfield Ag News about the potential impact of federal employee buyouts on food security. He warned that the rapid loss of experienced USDA staff, including workers, inspectors, and quality control professionals, could undermine the agency's ability to ensure food safety and availability.

Thanedar stated, "USDA may lose some



very talented, experienced workers who really understand the process and serve as a good quality control. All of this is in danger of being lost."

An estimated 20,000 federal employees have accepted the administration's buyout offer, which was extended to 2.3 million federal workers asking for de-

ferred resignations.

Additionally, Thanedar pointed to President Trump's tariffs and immigration policies as factors that will drive up food prices and strain the labor supply.

Representing the Detroit area, where one in four families rely on nutrition programs, Thanedar reflected on his own experience with hunger and his commitment to addressing food insecurity. "I understand why we cannot have young people, children, going to bed hungry because I did and I don't wish that upon anybody," he said.

Rep. Suhas Subramanyam Seeks To Assure Constituents At Town Hall

LEESBURG, VA – Representative Suhas Subramanyam (D-VA) took center stage at a packed town hall meeting on February 3, as hundreds of federal employees and concerned residents gathered to voice their fears over the Trump administration's latest workforce purge.

The meeting focused on the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE), a newly created agency led by Elon Musk that has aggressively pushed for federal job cuts and taken unprecedented control over key government offices.

Subramanyam opened the session by acknowledging the overwhelming number of emails, calls, and messages from constituents who fear losing their jobs. He specifically addressed the controversial "fork in the road"



emails received by many federal workers, which have been framed as voluntary buyouts but offer little transparency.


"It's kind of worded as a buyout, but it's not actually a buyout," Subramanyam warned. "It's basically telling you to resign in the next six to eight months. If you take this option, you don't have to come into work anymore. But there's no appropriation for this in Congress—there's no money set aside for these so-called buyouts." He urged employees to consult legal counsel or their unions before making any decisions.

Beyond job security, the meeting highlighted growing concerns over Musk's increasing access to government infrastructure and classified information. Subramanyam,

a member of the House Oversight and Accountability Committee, admitted that even he was being kept in the dark.

"We're getting very little information as members of Congress, and it's totally unacceptable," he said. "The DOGE committee has spoken with us never, basically." He encouraged residents to report any developments to his office and vowed to use his platform to push for transparency. Subramanyam also reassured attendees that despite House Democrats lacking a majority, they could still make their voices heard. "What we do have is the ability to speak up, to tell people's stories, and to use whatever leverage we have. I will hold town halls like this and make those stories public," he declared.

Reports of DOGE's extreme measures added to the outrage. One town hall attendee alleged that a top Musk aide, along with his wife and child, had moved into a federal agency's sixth floor, creating a restricted-access living space. The claim, first reported by The Daily Beast, underscores Musk's well-documented practice of encouraging employees to sleep at work—a strategy he previously implemented at Twitter and Tesla.





Indian Students Lead In Flouting U.S. Visa Rules; 7,000 Overstayed In 2023

India-West News Desk

WASHINGTON, DC – India had the highest number of student visa overstays in the U.S. last year, with 7,000 Indian students staying beyond their permitted time, according to U.S. immigration expert Jessica M. Vaughan. In comparison, Brazil and China, the next highest on the list, each had around 2,000 students overstaying their visas.

Speaking before the U.S. House Committee on the Judiciary, Vaughan warned that student and exchange visitor visas, especially F-1 (for academic students) and M-1 (for vocational students), have some of the highest overstay rates among all temporary visas.

Vaughan, a policy analyst at the Center



for Immigration Studies, argued that the current system is too lax and allows students to abuse their visa status. She called for stricter enforcement, requiring students to prove they intend to return home after their studies. She also criticized the "dual intent" policy, which lets student visa holders express interest in staying in the U.S. after graduation.

Programs like Optional Practical Training (OPT) and Curricular Practical Training (CPT), which allow international students to work in the U.S. after completing their education, were also flagged as vulnerable to fraud.

Vaughan recommended tighter controls and stricter standards for schools issuing I-20 forms, which are necessary for student visa applications. Schools with high overstay rates, she said, should lose their

authorization to sponsor foreign students.

Beyond student visas, Vaughan pushed for major reforms to work visa programs, including H-1B visas. She proposed cutting the total number of H-1B visas to 75,000 annually and prioritizing higher-paying employers. She also suggested reducing the visa duration for specialty occupations to two years with limited extensions.

Vaughan rejected claims of a labor shortage, citing unemployed U.S. STEM graduates. She argued that the U.S. should focus on hiring domestic workers before expanding foreign work programs. Her testimony adds to the growing debate on tightening immigration policies and curbing visa overstays, especially among Indian students.

ing Tandon's Sanskrit chants with the soothing sounds of flute and cello.

The title Triveni, which refers to the confluence of three rivers in Hindu tradition, symbolizes the fusion of diverse musical traditions.

Reacting to the win, Tandon emphasized the power of music to unite and heal, saying, "Music is love, music ignites the light within all of us, and, even in our darkest days, music spreads joy and laughter."

Tandon has long been an advocate for the spiritual and healing power of music,

explaining in a past interview with India-West, "To sing well the mind has to be in a very quiet place. The concept of spirituality to me is to be in that space...music has helped me find that quiet space."

A pioneer in blending Sanskrit chants with Western musical traditions, Tandon's work has been deeply influenced by her belief that music is a meditative practice. She shared with India-West, "When I sing, I am meditating, deep within myself. When I teach people to sing or am with students, I see God in them. That's my spirituality."

Her compositions have been performed at

prestigious venues like the World Cultural Festival and Lincoln Center. As Artist in Residence for the Young People's Chorus of New York City, Tandon has also received a New York State Council on the Arts grant to compose Sanskrit chants for choral ensembles.

Beyond her musical achievements, Tandon is a prominent philanthropist and business leader. The first South Asian American woman elected partner at McKinsey, she is the founder of Tandon Capital Associates and chairs the Krishnamurthy Tandon Foundation. She also serves as a trustee of NYU and chairs the NYU Tandon School of

Engineering, where she has supported various education initiatives.

Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi congratulated Tandon for her Grammy win. He posted, "Congratulations to @chandrikatandon on winning the Grammy for the album Triveni. We take great pride in her accomplishments as an entrepreneur, philanthropist, and, of course, music! It is commendable how she has remained passionate about Indian culture and has been working to popularize it. She is an inspiration for several people. I fondly recall meeting her in New York in 2023."

back its nationals found residing illegally abroad. He assured lawmakers that the Indian government was actively engaging with US authorities to ensure deportees were treated humanely.


"Deportations by the US are carried out by Immigration and Customs Enforcement following procedures in place since 2012, which include restraints. However, ICE has informed us that women and children are not restrained, and deportees' basic needs are taken care of," Jaishankar said in the Rajya Sabha. He emphasized that this process remains unchanged and applies to both chartered civilian and military aircraft.

Meanwhile, the United States Border Patrol Chief, Michael W. Banks, shared a 24-second video on X. His post stated, "Successfully returned illegal aliens



Accompanying the video was a firm warning: "If you cross illegally, you will be removed." It is unclear whether this was a video of Indians or a file video showing people in handcuffs.

The use of a US military aircraft for the deportation has drawn criticism from the opposition. Congress MP Shashi Tharoor remarked, "If you're in the US illegally, the US has the right to deport you. And if your identity as an Indian is confirmed, India has an obligation to accept you. However, it wasn't good to hear that they were brought back in a military plane, handcuffed, and so on... that was quite unnecessary."

Amid protests in Parliament over the Amid protests in Parliament over the inhuman manner" of deportation, Jaishankar reiterated that restraints were part of US procedures and assured that India was engaging with US authorities to ensure deportees were treated with dignity.

Jaishankar also called for stricter action against illegal migration networks while promoting legal travel. "We must crack down on illegal migration while easing visas for genuine travelers. Law enforcement agencies will act against those responsible based on information from deportees," he added.



Shyamalan Wins Court Battle Against Charges Of Plagiarism

RIVERSIDE, CA – A federal jury delivered a unanimous verdict in favor of M. Night Shyamalan and Apple on January 31, concluding a seven-day copyright trial regarding allegations that the streaming series Servant plagiarized elements from the 2013 film The Truth About Emanuel.

The lawsuit, filed by Italianborn director Francesca Gregorini, sought up to \$81 million in damages, claiming that Shyamalan, Apple, and others involved in Servant had stolen narrative elements from her film without proper credit. Gregorini, who argued that key plot points in Servant mirrored those in Emanuel, testified that she was advised against filing the lawsuit due to potential career repercussions. Nevertheless, she maintained her decision to stand up against what she viewed as widespread theft in the industry, Variety said.

Shyamalan, who co-created Servant with Tony Basgallop, strongly denied the accusations. He told the court that he and his team had never seen or heard of The Truth About Emanuel prior to the litigation. "This accusation is the exact opposite of everything I do and everything I try to repre-



sent," Shyamalan stated. "I would have never allowed it. None of the people that I work with would ever do anything like that."

During his testimony, Variety reported, Shyamalan was questioned about specific scenes and elements alleged to have been copied from Gregorini's film. He argued that certain tropes, such as a character fainting, were not original to her work. "We've all seen it hundreds and hundreds of times," he said, referencing works by Alfred Hitchcock like Rebecca, Notorious, and Saboteur. "It's just a thing no one owns."

The jury viewed both The Truth About Emanuel and the first three episodes of Servant before deliberating. After a full day of discussions, the jury ruled unanimously that the defendants had not had access to the film, despite its availability at Sundance and on iTunes. This meant they did not need to assess whether the two works were similar.

This decision wraps up a five-year legal battle, which began in 2020 after Servant debuted on Apple TV+. Although a federal judge initially dismissed the case, the 9th Circuit Court of Appeals revived it in 2022. Apple's motion for summary judgment was denied in November, leading to the trial's proceedings.

Servant has since concluded its four-season run, and the trial's outcome clears Shyamalan and Apple of the copyright infringement charges.

Kal Penn Wants A Hollywood Remake Of Bollywood's 'Don'

JAIPUR – Indian American actor Kal Penn has expressed interest in remaking Amitabh Bachchan's 1978 film Don for Hollywood, setting it in Brooklyn or Ohio. He shared this idea during a session titled You Can't Be Serious at the Jaipur Literature Festival, held at Hotel Clarks Amer.

Penn, best known for The Namesake and the Harold and Kumar franchise, spoke about his admiration for Bachchan and the film's lasting impact. "Who isn't a huge Amitabh Bachchan fan? The original Don is what I would love to remake. It can still be escapist, with the same color palette, just set in Brooklyn or Ohio," he said.

The 47-year-old actor also reflected on his influences, citing Hollywood icons Tom Hanks and Denzel Washington, along with filmmaker Mira Nair. He credited Nair's Mississippi Masala as an inspiration for his career.

Penn, whose credits include Bhopal: A Prayer for Rain, Designated Survivor, and The Big Bang Theory, also shared his experiences with Indian television. He recalled visiting the sets of Taarak Mehta Ka Ooltah Chashmah and spoke about his interest in Hindi serials, particularly Saath Nibhaana Saathiya.

"I try to keep up with Hindi by watching serials. I got addicted to Saath Nibhaana Saathiya. Kokila Ben is formidable, and Gopi is obviously a meme now," he said.
