NEW DELHI (ANI) - Narendra Modi took oath as Prime Minister for his third successive term at an impressive ceremony at Rashtrapati Bhavan on June 9 evening with 71 MPs from the BJP and its allies joining the party-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) government.

President Droupadi Murmu administered the oath of office at the ceremony which was attended by leaders from India's neighborhood and Indian Ocean region.

Nepal PM Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda', Sri Lanka President Ranil Wickremesinghe, Bhutan PM Tshering Tobgay, Maldives President Mohamed Muizzu, Mauritius Prime Minister Pravind Jugnauth, Sevchelles Vice President Ahmed Afif and Bangladesh PM Sheik Hasina attended the swearing-in ceremony

S Jaishankar taking oath of office and all of them retaining their portfolions. Several young leaders from BJP and allies, including first-time MPs, also made it to the council of ministers. Actor-turnedpolitician Suresh Gopi, who is the first BJP MP from Kerala and Harsh Malhotra, who won Lok Sabha polls from East Delhi, are among the first-time MPs in the union cabinet.

BJP chief JP Nadda also took oath as union minister in an indication that the party could have a new chief.

The government now has 30 cabinet ministers, five Ministers of State with Independent charge, and 36 Ministers of State. Most MPs took the oath in Hindi while some took it in English.

The Union cabinet also has five former chief ministers - Shivraj Singh Chouhan, Manohar Lal Khattar, HD Kumaraswamy, Sarbananda Sonowal and Jitan Ram Manjhi.

Spelling Bee Champ Wants To Donate His Prize Money

ANNAPOLIS, MD – In a night filled with anticipation and excitement, 12-year-old Bruhat Soma from St. Petersburg, FL, emerged as the champion of the 2024 Scripps National Spelling Bee. Bruhat clinched victory in the second-ever spell-off, a dramatic tiebreaker round, by correctly spelling 29 words within 90 seconds. His final and winning word was "abseil," meaning "a descent in mountaineering by means of a rope looped over a projection above."

The seventh grader not only secured the prestigious Scripps Cup trophy but also took home a \$50,000 cash prize. Expressing his excitement about winning the championship, Bruhat said, "When I won, I was excited and happy because I had been working hard for the past year. Winning felt like a dream come true."

The prize money of \$50,000, Bruhat intends to donate it. "I've decided to donate the \$50,000 to a good cause, but I haven't chosen the cause yet. It will be for a good cause," he said.

Soma said, "In India, I'm from Telangana. I might go back during any summer vacation or for my relative's wedding. But, yeah, it depends. I'll probably go back pretty soon." Bruhat's victory is significant for many in India who were rooting for him. "A lot of my relatives are in India. They've sent congratulations and watched the video. It's exciting to know that all my relatives back in India were supporting me," he said.







As the ruling Bhartiya Janta Party-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) formed the

government for the third consecutive time, here are some key observations:

The BJPled NDA was expected to outperform its last two results by winning 400 seats, this time out of 543 in the

lower house of the parliament in the general elections; the BJP's race seems to have concluded much lower than that.

The BJP will need to ensure that its pre-poll coalition partners adhere to the party's leadership and do not join the Congress-led I.N.D.I.A alliance to form a government because, as an NDA coalition, the BJP has the needed numbers to form the government.

The opposition, including the I.N.D.I.A alliance has performed exceedingly well in the elections, and there are many reasons for this, including anti-incumbency in certain states, resistance to BJP's 'Hindutva' ideology among minority groups, state-specific local issues, and unemployment.

* The BJP is in a coalition government, which is often unstable and runs into conflicts of power and interests. Smaller parties demand bigger stakes in the government now and then.

* Although the BJP has formed the government, it needs to do a lot of rethinking and introspection, especially regarding why its development politics did not convince the voters this time.

* As the clouds clear, it will be interesting to see whether the minority Muslim population voted for the BJP or not because the BJP's 'Hindutva' ideology is often seen as conflicting with the Constitution's secular nature.

Why The BJP Lost Ground, What To Expect From Modi 3.0





Why the BJP lost:

- The assumption that the BJP was undefeatable under Prime Minister Narendra Modi, whose two terms have seen India's economic rise, seems misplaced.

- In states like Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra, which bring the largest share of the seat tally to any party, BJP has suffered huge losses.

- The regional parties have made a comeback in national politics, particularly in the states of Uttar Pradesh, Maharashtra, and West Bengal-all have gone to regional parties allying with the I.N.D.I.A alliance.

- The BJP continues to face challenges in winning significant support in the southern states of Tamil Nadu and Kerala due to the strong presence of regional parties. The BJP's 'Hindutva' philosophy, rooted in Hindu nationalism, encounters resistance in these states because the Southern states still stick to their historical and cultural roots of social justice and regional identity.

- The BJP was expecting the construction of the Ram Temple in Ayodhya-a disputed site between Hindus and Muslims for decades and finally won by Hindus in the apex court as their place of worship. It would help them earn the most Hindu votes. But Hindu votes have been largely divided.

Modi 3.0: Challenges and Prospects

- The BJP-led NDA government has promised to make India the third-largest economy by 2017, which will not be difficult, consider-

ing the current GDP growth rate of 8.5 percent. However, a coalition government always runs into trouble, especially when devising economic plans. The coalition's compulsions will be a catalyst in the development sector.

- The BJP faces the challenge of addressing large-scale unemployment,

which seems to have worked in the opposition's favor as they focused on it in their election campaigns and manifesto. The BJP was seemingly in denial of the scale and status of unemployment in India.

– The BJP will need to introspect its reliance on Hindu voters, as this group is increasingly divided. While the construction of a temple in Ayodhya has been a significant issue, it may not be sufficient to secure their votes. Economic concerns, social issues, and regional dynamics are also crucial factors that the BJP must address to maintain broad support among Hindu voters.

Foreign policy in the next five years

-In his third term, Modi's foreign policy goals will focus on securing India's permanent membership in the UN Security substantial, with the PLA continuing to claim Indian territories. The BJP will focus on upgrading India's defense capabilities and enhancing infrastructure along the India-China border.

- Ties with the United States

have strengthened under Modi's leadership. India finds a welcoming space in the United States. Following recent cooperation in the trade and tech sectors, bilateral cooperation is expected to grow further.

- Modi will continue to maintain traditional ties with Russia despite the growing bond between Moscow and Beijing and mounting pressure over the Ukraine issue.

- India has developed a thick skin on the Ukraine issue. While advocating for a peaceful resolution of the war, it also focuses on its national interests, including buying oil and defense equipment.

- India will seek a leadership role in the Global South and present itself as a strong voice for Global South countries. The G20 Summit in Delhi in 2023 provided momentum for Indian foreign policy, which Modi 3.0 will certainly aim to continue.





his previous performances in the Bee. He tied for 163rd place in 2022 and improved to 74th place in 2023. He has become the 28th Indian American champion, continuing a notable trend over the past two decades.

Bruhat faced stiff competition from Faizan Zaki, a fellow 12-year-old and Indian American from Texas, who spelled 20 words correctly but stumbled on four. The spell-off was intense, with Bruhat's rapid pace setting a high bar early on.

The Bee final featured eight competitors. Rishabh Saha from Merced, CA, was eliminated in the first round after misspelling "desmotrope." Shrey Parikh from San Bernardino, CA, the youngest finalist at 12, finished in the Top 4 after misspelling "kanin." Aditi Muthukumar from Denver, CO, improved her ranking from tying for 74th place last year to finishing in the Top 5 this year, before being eliminated on "Lillooet." Ananya Prassanna from Charlotte, NC, who tied for 74th place in 2023 and 49th in 2022, ended her Bee journey after misspelling "murrina," finishing as a finalist in her last Bee.

Looking ahead, Bruhat said, "I want to be a doctor when I grow

Indian American Grandfather Summits Everest

LEONIA, NJ - After years of training and climbing various mountains, Jafar Ismail signed up to climb the world's tallest mountain, Mt. Everest, which stands at 29,032 feet.

A resident of Leonia in Bergen County, Jafar and his wife, Lubna, both grew up in India. They have five children and a precious young grandchild, Zakaria. Jafar graduated from Marine Engineering College, Kolkata (also known as DMET) and holds a graduate degree in Computer Science from Iona University, NY.

In January 2023, after climbing Mt. Aconcagua (22,837 feet) in Argentina—the highest peak in the Americas-Jafar contemplated climbing Mt. Everest before time ran out. "I am 59 years old," he told India-West, "and I wanted to fulfill this childhood dream before time ran out!"

To prepare for this challenge, Jafar focused on cardio training. He acclimatizes well to high altitudes and wanted to be in the best cardio health for Nepal so as a part of this quest, he completed the NYC Marathon in November 2023 and ran several other half marathons.

As part of his Everest training, Jafar did a practice climb on Lobuche (20,075 feet). Then, with the team, he went through "rotations," where climbers ascend to higher camps, such as Camp 3, and return to base camp. This helps climbers acclimatize to higher elevations. After some rest and recuperation, Jafar said they waited at Everest Base Camp for the weather to clear.

Jafar said he spent the time recording and sending Bollywood love songs to Lubna, who laughingly told India-West that he can't carry a tune!

Detailing the sequence of events, Jafar said that once the weather cleared, they moved to Camp 1, spent a night, then moved to Camp 2 where they spent two nights, and then to Camp 3. The next day, they finally arrived at Camp 4 around 4 pm for the final leg of their climb. The summit push started at 7:30 pm. From base camp, they climbed about 11,000 feet over 14 miles, reaching the summit at 7:24 am Nepal time on May 19, 2024.

The way down had some unnerving moments. Jafar's oxygen mask started leaking, causing his vision to blur, he said. The descent, which usually takes about five hours to Camp 4, took him nine hours. Upon reaching Camp



2, the lead Sherpa decided it was too dangerous for Jafar to climb down in his condition, and a helicopter evacuation was ordered.

Fortunately, after a few days of rest at a hospital and hotel in Kathmandu, Jafar headed home to his wife and family in New Jersey. Jafar left his corporate job in 2022 as an Information Technology Manager to join Lubna's business. They now run several restaurants and franchise businesses.

"It was very stressful to watch his attempt from halfway around the world," said Lubna, "but I am glad he is home and now I am locking up all his mountaineering gear forever!"

Vivek Ranadive Wants To Make Sacramento A Sports Hub

SACRAMENTO, CA – Sacramento Kings owner Vivek Ranadivé announced a deal to host the Oakland A's at a renovated Sutter Health Park in West Sacramento for the next three seasons, with an option for a fourth, as the team's permanent home in Las Vegas won't be ready until 2028. The A's current lease in Oakland expires after the 2024 season.

Alternative interim options such as Salt Lake City were also discussed, but Sacramento emerged as the preferred choice after months of negotiations. This is in line with Ranadive's vision to make Sacramento a hub for sports. "I want people to have something to do every single night of the year. I want them to have multiple options, not just one," he said.

Ranadivé said that bringing the A's to Sacramento was a test for a permanent MLB team. "They are planning to cre-

ate a new team on the West Coast, preferably in California. This is a showcase for us. If we can demonstrate that there's a viable market here and make the team successful, I believe we're in a strong position to secure the new franchise," media outlet KCRA 3 quoted Ranadive as saying.

About MLB's long-term presence in Sacramento, he acknowledged there were no guarantees. "We have to prove ourselves," Ranadivé said. "I have full confidence that with our incredible city and the best fans in the world, we can make it happen."

CalTech Professor Wins Shaw Prize In Astronomy

PASADENA, CA – Shrinivas R. Kulkarni, has been honored with the prestigious Shaw Prize in Astronomy for his pioneering discoveries related to millisecond pulsars, gamma-ray bursts, supernovae, and other transient astronomical objects.

Kulkarni is the George Ellery Hale Professor of Astronomy and Planetary Science at the California Institute of Technology's Division of Physics, Mathematics, and Astronomy.

The Shaw Prize Foundation announced the 2024 laureates on May 21, highlighting Kulkarni's significant contributions to timedomain astronomy. His work led to the creation and leadership of the Palomar Transient Factory and its successor, the Zwicky Transient Facility, which dramatically advanced understanding of the variable optical sky.

"The Shaw Prize in Astronomy is awarded to Shrinivas R. Kulkarni for his ground-breaking discoveries about millisecond pulsars, gamma-ray bursts, supernovae, and other variable or transient astronomical objects," the foundation stated. "His



contributions to time-domain astronomy culminated in the conception, construction, and leadership of the Palomar Transient Factory and its successor, the Zwicky Transient Facility."

Alongside Kulkarni, the other Shaw Prize awardees for 2024 include Swee Lay Thein and Stuart Orkin, who received the Shaw Prize in Life Science and Medicine, and Peter Sarnak, who was awarded the Shaw Prize in Mathematical Sciences. Each of the three annual prizes carries a monetary award of \$1.2 million. The award ceremony is scheduled for November 12, in Hong Kong.

Shrinivas R. Kulkarni grew up in Karnataka and began his academic journey began with a Master's degree from the Indian Institute of Technology in 1978, followed by a Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley in 1983.

His university webpage says, "I love music and like my research, I switch my focus every few years. I have successively been a fan of Salsa, Qawali, Latin Jazz and music from Mali. I am a great student of macro-finance and especially financial meltdowns. Finally, I love rabbits since they best reflect my personality."

Krish Pai Wins \$50,000 Regeneron Young Scientist Award

LOS ANGELES, CA – Regeneron Pharmaceuticals, Inc. and the Society for Science on May 17 announced that Krish Pai, 17, of Del Mar, California, received the second Regeneron Young Scientist Award at the 2024 Regeneron International Science and Engineering Fair (ISEF). This is the world's largest pre-college science and engineering competition.

Indian American Krish was awarded a \$50,000 prize for his innovative machine-learning research aimed at identifying microbial genetic sequences that can be modified to biodegrade plastic.

Krish has developed a groundbreaking software called Microby, which scans databases of microorganisms to determine which ones can be genetically altered to biodegrade plastics. During testing, he identified two microorganisms that could be modified to degrade plastic at a cost he estimates to be ten times less than traditional recycling methods.

In total, over \$9 million was awarded to finalists for their creativity, innovation, and depth of scientific inquiry. The competition featured nearly 2,000 young



scientists from 49 U.S. states and nearly 70 countries, regions, and territories worldwide.

Other Indian American winners included Tanishka Balaji Aglave, 15, of Valrico, Florida, and Ria Kamat, 17, of Hackensack, New Jersey.

Tanishka received the H. Robert Horvitz Prize for Fundamental Research of \$10,000 for her investigation into a natural alternative treatment against citrus greening, a disease that threatens citrus farming worldwide and is currently only treated with antibiotics. She injected the trunks of infected trees with an extract from the curry leaf tree and found that this method could effectively and sustainably

manage citrus greening disease.

Ria, a student at Bergen County Academies, received the Dudley R. Herschbach SIYSS Award, which provides finalists an all-expense-paid trip to attend the Stockholm International Youth Science Seminar during Nobel Week in Stockholm, Sweden. Her project examined the relationship between tumorinduced osteoclastogenesis and osteoprotegerin. Other Indian Americans among the 450 finalists were also recognized for their innovative research and received \$5,000 as prize money:

Biomedical Engineering – Ayush Garg, Dublin, California; Divij Motwani, Palo Alto, California; Akash Ashish Pai, Portland, Oregon.

Chemistry – Akilan Sankaran, Albuquerque, New Mexico; Arjun Suresh Malpani and Siddharth Daniel D'costa, Portland, Oregon.

Earth and Environmental Sciences – Nikhil Vemuri, Durham, North Carolina.

Physics and Astronomy – Harini Thiagarajan and Vishal Ranganath Yalla, Bothell, Washington.

Nikesh Arora Named Second Highest-Paid CEO In US By Wall Street Journal


WASHINGTON, DC (IANS) – In the midst of the debate over the outrageous sums being earned by top managements across corporates becomes more and more transparent and is drawing the ire of many, Nikesh Arora, the Indiaborn CEO of Palo Alto Networks, has been ranked as America's second-highest-paid CEO in 2023.

A total of 17 Indian-descent CEOs are in the top 500 rankings, according to an analysis published by The Wall Street Journal on May 21.

Shantanu Narayen of Adobe is the second-highest-paid Indiandescent CEO, ranked 11 overall. Arora and Narayen earned \$151.43 million and \$44.93 million, respectively, more than Tesla's Elon Musk, who did not receive any compensation in 2023, according to the report.

Meta's Mark Zuckerberg earned \$24.40 million, while Alphabet's India-born head Sundar Pichai earned \$8.80 million during the period under review.

A product of Delhi's Air Force Public School, Arora first drew international attention as the chief business officer at Google, which he left in 2014 to head SoftBank with a reported compensation that was



said to be a record for Japan.

Arora has been heading Palo Alto Networks, a cybersecurity company, since 2018. His compensation at Palo Alto Networks consists mostly of equity awards that include shares granted over three years.

Narayen, who was born and raised in Hyderabad, has been the CEO of Adobe since 2007 after joining the company in 1998.

Hock Tan of Broadcom topped the list with earnings of \$162 million.

Ranked third, fourth, and fifth among Indian Americans were Sanjay Malhotra of Micron Technology (63rd, \$25.28 million), Ajei Gopal of Ansys (66th, \$24.63 million), and Reshma Kewalramani of Vertex Pharmaceuticals (118th, \$20.59 million).

Others included Arvind Krishna of IBM (123rd, \$20.40 million), Badrinarayn Kothandaraman of Enphase Energy (135th, \$19.53 million), Sanjiv Lamba

of Linde (143rd, \$19.20 million), Surendralal Karsanbhai of Emerson electric (158th, \$18.32 million), Anirudh Devgun of Cadence Design Systems (172nd, \$17.34 million), Shankha Mitra of Wellflower (174th, \$17.20 million), Sumit Roy of Realty Income (268th, \$13.13 million), Satish Dhanasekaran of Keysight Technologies (319th, \$10.75 million), Prahlad Singh of Rewity (357th, \$9.13 million), Sundar Pichai of Alphabet (364th, \$8.80 million), Udit Batra of Waters (367th, \$8.74 million), and Sundarrajan Nagarajan of Nordson (389th, \$6.98 million).

Musk Lauds Ashok Elluswamy Who Leads AI At Tesla



SAN FRANCISCO, CA (IANS) – Lauding engineer Ashok Elluswamy, who was the first recruit of Tesla's Autopilot team, Elon Musk on June 9 expressed gratitude towards him, saying that "without him and our awesome team, we would just be another car company looking for an autonomy supplier that does not exist".

This comes after Elluswamy, in his detailed note, said that Musk has been the key driver of AI and autonomy at Tesla. "He has always pushed us to achieve great things, even when such ideas were seemingly impossible at the time," it added.

Later, the tech billionaire quoted Elluswamy's post on X and wrote, "Thanks Ashok! Ashok was the first person to join the Tesla AI/ Autopilot team and ultimately rose to lead all AI/Autopilot software".

"Btw, I never suggested that he say anything, and I had no idea he

wrote this until I saw it 10 minutes ago," he added.

Elluswamy, in his note, shared an instance that goes back to 2014, when "autopilot started on a ridiculously tiny computer".

"Back in 2014, Autopilot started on a ridiculously tiny computer that only had about 384 KB of memory and puny computer (didn't even have native floating-point arithmetic). He asked the engineering team to implement lane keeping, lane changing, longitudinal control for vehicles, curvature, etc.," the engineer wrote.

"Many, even in the team, thought that the request was crazy. Nonetheless, he never gave up and pushed the team to achieve this very difficult goal. In 2015, beyond all odds, Tesla shipped the world's first Autopilot system. The second closest such product only came to market many years later," he added.

Dr Reddy's, Sun Pharma, Aurobindo Recall Products In US



WASHINGTON, DC (IANS) - Drug makers Dr Reddy's Laboratories, Sun Pharma and Aurobindo Pharma are recalling their products in the US due to manufacturing issues.

According to the latest Enforcement Report by the US Food and Drug Administration (USFDA), Dr Reddy's Laboratories is recalling Javygtor (sapropterin dihydrochloride) Powder for Oral Solution (100mg) due to it being a 'Sub-potent Drug'.

Sapropterin dihydrochloride is used to treat hyperphenylalaninemia (HPA), which is characterized by elevated amounts of phenylalanine in the blood. The company is also recalling an additional lot of sapropterin dihydrochloride for the same reason.

As per USFDA, the drug maker started the Class I recall in the US on April 8.

In addition, the USFDA mentioned that Sun Pharma is recalling 11,016 vials of Amphotericin B Liposome for Injection, which

is used to treat fungal infections.

The drug maker initiated the Class II recall on April 19 due to being "Out of specification

Similarly, Aurobindo Pharma is recalling 13,605 bottles of Clorazepate Dipotassium Tablets (3.75 mg and 7.5 mg) from the US market. Clorazepate Dipotassium Tablets are used to treat anxiety.

According to the USFDA, the recall is due to "Discoloration: Dotted and yellow spots on tablets". The company began the Class II recall on April 24. Additionally, the USFDA mentioned that FDC Ltd is recalling 382,104 units of Timolol Maleate Ophthalmic Solution, which is used to treat glaucoma. The drug maker is recalling the affected lot due to a "Defective Container".

Earlier this month, drug makers Cipla and Glenmark recalled their products from the US market due to manufacturing issues.

Purdue Educated Ram Mohan Naidu, 36, Is Youngest Ever Union Minister

AMARAVATI, (IANS) – Telugu Desam Party's Kinjarapu Ram Mohan Naidu has become the youngest-ever Union Minister after he took oath as a member of the Narendra Modi-led Cabinet on June 9. He will handle the civil aviation ministry.

The 36-year-old was elected to the Lok Sabha from Srikakulam in Andhra Pradesh for a third consecutive term in the recently concluded Lok Sabha elections.

The US-educated leader is carrying forward the political legacy of his late father K. Yerran Naidu, who too had served as a Union Minister.

He pursued his undergraduate degree in electrical engineering from Purdue University, followed by a postgraduate degree in MBA from Long Island, NY

Serving as a national General Secretary of the TDP, he is considered one of the key loyalists of Naidu, who is set to become the Chief Minister of the state.

Ram Mohan, along with Chandrababu Naidu's son Nara Lokesh, played a key role in Delhi in mobilizing support for the TDP chief

when he was arrested last year in a corruption case.

With fluency in English and Hindi, Ram Mohan has become an asset for the TDP who always accompanies Chandrababu Naidu during his visits to Delhi.

He served on various Parliamentary committees, underscoring his grip over diverse subjects. He was a member of the Standing Committee on Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, and Food Processing.

He also served as a member of the Standing Committees on Railways and Home Affairs, the Consultative Committee on Ministry of Tourism and Culture, and the Committee on Welfare of Other Backward Classes and Official Language Department in the 16th Lok Sabha. Ram Mohan was honored with the Sansad Ratna award in 2020 for his performance as an MP.

Married to Shri Sravya in 2017, Ram Mohan was blessed with a girl in 2021. Ram Mohan has also broken stereotypes in politics. His decision to take paternity leave during the 2021 budget session for his wife's pregnancy sparked healthy discussions on gender rights and education. He also took various initiatives to encourage youth participation in politics, conducting youth direct internships both in his constituency and in the Parliament over the last decade, with over 175 individuals interning with him virtually or on the field. The young leader's hobbies include photography, which he pursued seriously during his college days. He is also an avid sports enthusiast, with a particular fondness for basketball and cricket.

Ram Mohan's uncle K. Atchen Naidu is the President of TDP's Andhra Pradesh unit.



Pemmasani Chandra Sekhar From Texas Becomes Union Minister In India

AMARAVATI, (IANS) – Telugu Desam Party's Pemmasani Chandra Sekhar, the Indian American doctor who took oath as Union Minister of State on June 9, is a first-time MP and the richest with declared family assets of more than Rs 5,705 crore. He has been given Rural Development and Communications.

As per the affidavit submitted to the Election Commission, Chandra Sekhar and his wife Koneru Sriratna both are in business. He is also a member of the Forbes Business Council and the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin.

He has helped to accommodate a hundred borewells in Palnadu district of Andhra Pradesh since 2010, establishing Reverse



He lives with his parents in Johns Creek and while running his campaign graduated Georgetown Law School this week. With this result, he plans to defer taking his bar exam. Ramaswami's parents immigrated to the US from Tamil Nadu in 1990.

Thanedar's Main Opponent Is Disqualified **Advancing Reelection Chances**

WASHINGTON, DC - Congressman Shri Thanedar's main opponent in the Democratic primary for his reelection has taken a turn with Adam Hollier being disqualified for not submitting the necessary number of valid voter signatures.

Thanedar had formally challenged the validity of Hollier's petitions, asserting that his fellow Democrat should be removed from the

Wayne County Clerk Cathy Garret's staff report said that Hollier had submitted signatures of 1,553 voters. Of these, only 863 were found to be valid against the mandatory signature of 1,000 voters. Thanedar in his challenge had drawn attention to 575 signatures. The report said many of the signatures had clear indications that they were not genuine. Hollier can still appeal the verdict. In his statement, he alluded to the idea that he had trusted the process as a candidate and become a victim of fraud.

Thanedar said, "I personally collected hundreds of signatures and enjoyed

talking to my constituents directly and listening to their concerns." Local media are now speculating what the Black Caucus, which had endorsed Hollier will now do. There have been reports of racial anger, as Michigan's 13th District is predominantly Black and Thanedar is the first non-black representative in the area.





Ravi Bhalla Runs Fierce Campaign But Is Defeated By Menendez

India-West News Desk

HOBOKEN, NJ – Hoboken Mayor Ravi Bhalla has been defeated by Rep. Rob Menendez (D-Jersey City) in the Democratic primary for New Jersey's 8th congressional district, following an intense and costly campaign.

Bhalla, who made history as one of the first Sikh mayors in the US, ran on a platform of reform, criticizing Menendez for his family connections and the recent federal corruption charges against his father, Senator Bob Menendez. Bhalla argued that New Jersey needed to move beyond the Menendez family's influence in politics.

Despite Bhalla's strong show-

ing in the Jersey City and Hoboken areas, Menendez secured a decisive lead in Newark, Elizabeth, and other towns within the district, the New Jersey Monitor said. Menendez, 38, first won his congressional seat in 2022, capitalizing on his position as a Port Authority commissioner and his father's political network. However, the bribery charges against Senator Bob Menendez last fall turned those connections into a significant vulnerability for his



son's campaign.

Financially, the race was highly competitive, with Bhalla spending \$1.6 million and Menendez \$1.3 million by mid-May. Additionally, independent expenditure groups injected at least \$1.8 million into the district, predominantly supporting Menendez and opposing Bhalla.

The Congressional Hispanic Caucus's BOLD PAC was a major contributor, aiming to ensure the continuation of Hispanic representation in New Jersey's congressional delegation.

BURLINGTON, NJ – Rajesh Mohan has secured the Republican nomination in the primary race for New Jersey's 3rd District House seat. Mohan and his wife, Nandini, have been married for 33 years and have two sons; one is an engineer and the other a lawyer.

of Indian descent from India or the Caribbean, accounting for 26 percent of the area's population.

According to the city, "The southern portion of Richmond Hill is home to several tight-knit communities, such as the Punjabi Sikh".

CBS New York reported that the man's father, Bhupinder Multani, told the station that he did not know what set off his older son.

Asked by the station's reporter if the sons had any issues, he said: "Not big problems. Sometimes little disagreements, no problems."

He said that the family had settled in for a quiet evening with pizza when Multani opened the door to his brother's room and shot him without warning. The father said that he ran to the house of a neighbor to seek help. The neighbor told the station that when she entered the house, she found Vipanpal wounded and pleading for help.

"He told me, 'Please, don't let me die'," the neighbor said, and died later "in my hands".

Jaspreet Singh, the brother-inlaw of the two men, told the station that Multani "was one of the nicest, coolest guys, always joking around". "What could be going on in his mind to explode like that," he wondered.

The New York Post reported that, according to his family, Multani was the father of three and was financially sound with no known problems. A neighbor, Alvin Debieen, told the New York Daily News that they thought it was firecrackers going off when they heard the sound, but when they heard the police sirens, "we kind of just figured someone was shot".

"It had to be something really serious, or he just snapped," Debieen said.

A neighbor from where Multani's body was found, told the newspaper that "His body was right there laid out in the open and there was a lot of blood".

FBI Sacramento Wants Indian Americans To Report Extortion

India-West Staff Reporter

SACRAMENTO, CA – In a public statement, the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Sacramento Field Office has warned of an extortion scheme affecting individuals with familial or business ties to

The field office is tracking several instances throughout its 34-county area of responsibility in which people were targeted for extortion and threatened with violence. These criminal acts are believed to be underreported.

"The FBI and its law enforcement partners urge the public to report these crimes to ensure the individuals committing these alleged crimes face justice," it said.

"We are deeply concerned for the safety and economic security of our neighbors of Indian descent who have been targeted," said Acting Special Agent in Charge Mark Remily, who leads the FBI Sacramento Field Office. "Criminals are targeting hard-working, law-abiding business owners and are using thug tactics to extort them in clear violation of the law. Timely reporting of attempted extortion to the authorities will

help law enforcement to identify and disrupt this criminal scheme, ensuring the safety and economic security of the community."



In recent extortion attempts, subjects demanded a large sum of money and threatened physical violence or death if the demand was not met. Individuals who disregarded the demands subsequently became victims of violence, including targeted shootings at their residences and vehicles, the FBI said.

Anyone who believes they are in immediate danger should call 911. Threats of violence intended to extort victims for a specified sum can be reported to the FBI by calling the local field office, submitting a tip online at tips.fbi. gov, or calling 1-800-CALL-FBI (1-800-225-5324).

The FBI can connect callers with language services to ensure clear communication for callers.

Raising Human Rights Concerns In India Does Not Undermine Ties With US Say Lawmakers

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Indian American lawmakers emphasized their commitment to addressing human rights issues in India but noted that lecturing New Delhi on the matter is counterproductive. Instead, they advocated for a dialogue with Indian leaders to express their concerns constructively.

At the "Desi Decides" Summit of Indian American Impact on May 16, Congressman Ro Khanna, co-chair of the Congressional India Caucus, highlighted the need for a nuanced approach.

Joining Khanna in the panel dis-

cussion were lawmakers Shri Thanedar, Pramila Jayapal, and Dr. Ami Bera. Moderated by ABC national correspondent Zohreen Shah, the discussion touched on Prime Minister Narendra Modi's relations with India's Muslims.

Khanna suggested a more constructive approach: "Having a conversation about the imperfections in our democracy and India's, and how to

collectively advance democracy and human rights, is more productive."

Bera echoed Khanna's sentiments, stressing the importance of India's secular nature. "If India loses its secular identity, it changes its essence and global perception," Bera said. He however expressed concerns about press freedom and the viability of opposition in India. "A vibrant democracy requires freedom of speech, press, and

opposition. I hope India's democracy remains robust," he added.

Pramila Jayapal agreed with Bera and Khanna, underscoring the responsibility to critique both domestic and international issues. "We shouldn't lecture, but we must consider all U.S. interests, including values like freedom of religion and press," Jayapal stated. She stressed that raising concerns about human rights aligns with American values and does not undermine U.S.-India relations.

Shri Thanedar supported a strong U.S.-India partnership, urging India to solidify its commitment to the U.S. "India should recognize its economic power and role in countering China's aggression.



ous technological devices like smartphones, computers, and electric vehicles.


Kara's investigation takes readers deep into the heart of cobalt territory, documenting the voices of the Congolese people

Indian American Creatives Celebrate Heritage And The Power Of Names





Alex Gibney To Direct Salman Rushdie Documentary Based On Memoir 'Knife'

LOS ANGELES, CA (IANS) - A documentary centered around novelist Salman Rushdie, based on his memoir 'Knife: Meditations After an Attempted Murder', will be directed by Oscar-winner Alex Gibney. he was giving at Chautauqua's amphitheater stage.

He lost vision in one eye and was left incapacitated in one hand.

Through Rushdie's wife Rachel Eliza Griffiths' footage, which has never been seen by the public, the documentary will follow the writer during not only his physical recovery but also the recovery of his spirit and hope for the future reports variety.com.

In 'Knife', Rushdie writes, "it's a story in which hatred, the knife as a metaphor of hate, is answered, and finally overcome, by love."

"I set out to capture Manisha's journey and underscore how education is not just a privilege, but a fundamental human right," explains Angel. "The film showcases how Vibha equips underprivileged youth like Manisha with quality schooling and English skills to unlock their full potential."

The screening drew a coalition of education advocates, civic leaders, and influencers. Among them was Beverly Hills Vice Mayor Dr. Sharona Nazarian, signaling the city's prioritization of scholastic reform. Shauna Shapiro represented Showcase Entertainment, while Emmy-winning journalist Stella Inger-Escobedo moderated an insightful panel discussion.

Attendees included Nalini and Daniel Jokmels from Capstone, social justice attorneys Jennifer Sahota and Nileema Gavini of Gavini Law, and Vibha board member Monika Erande, who embodies the non-profit's grassroots efforts.

During the event, Erande participated in several interviews where she emphasized: "English serves as a global language, essential for international communication. In the context of India, higher education often takes place in English, making it crucial for children to learn the language to access better educational opportunities."

Though set in India, the film casts a glaring spotlight on the crisis afflicting American public schools, where two-thirds of children struggle with basic reading literacy. Through Manisha's perseverance, the documentary encapsulates how access to quality education can transform lives and communities.

"Our children's futures hinge on equipping them with essential skills like communication and critical thinking to thrive in our rapidly evolving world," Angel urges. "By fostering collaboration between educators, parents and stakeholders, we can nurture each student's unique talents and identities."

As "The Audacity to Dream" continues its screening tour, Vibha hopes it will be a clarion call that unites a broad coalition to dismantle systemic barriers.




mandi, and her vindictive niece Fareedan (Sonakshi Sinha), who has ambitions to take her aunt's place.




